I'm Glad You Are Here

When you visit Disneyland or Walt Disney World, you can stop by the City Hall on Main Street and request a complementary button as a celebration and souvenir of your trip. Buttons read, "Happily Ever After" (celebrating an engagement, wedding or anniversary), "1st Visit," "It's My Birthday," etc.

On a recent visit, I noticed that whenever a Cast Member (Disney employee) would pass somebody wearing one of the buttons, they would offer an appropriate greeting like, "It's great to have you here." or "Happy Birthday!" There was no other interaction. The park guest was not asked to fill out a guest card or take a survey or receive some piece of literature about Disney. It was simply about being welcoming and making them feel special.

Every week we have guests that attend our Bible classes, worship gatherings and events. And although we do not put an "I'm Celebrating" button on any of them, we should be consciously watching for those guests and greet them with a smile and "I am glad that you're here!" We don't have to get all of their personal information, or see that they are made aware of every program and event that we have; just make them feel welcome.

It's wonderful to interact with our fellow brothers and sisters. In fact, that is an essential part of the reason why we gather together. However, the mission that Jesus has given us is to reach out beyond our church family to the world, much of which does not yet know Jesus. Some of our guests have come looking for help and hope... they are looking for Jesus.

Hospitality is "the quality or attitude of receiving and treating guests and strangers in a warm, friendly, generous way." It's showing love towards others, leading them to the love of Jesus and bringing glory to God as we allow Him to fulfill His will for us. Practicing guest hospitality is watching for people that you do not know or have not seen before. It's speaking to them and making them a priority. It's making them feel welcomed and valued.

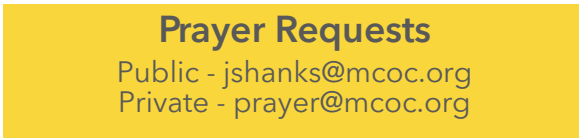
SERVING OPPORTUNITIES
