BE HUMBLE - LOVE LIKE JESUS

Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others. In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus. Philippians 2:3-5a

Philippians 2 tells us to be humble and love people like Jesus. You never know when you will be asked to help someone you know or don't know and maybe do something outside your comfort zone, which will probably come at an inconvenient time.

It happened on a cold January morning in 1998 after a Youth Minister conference in Colorado. I was out of state, without transportation, with no family in the area, hurting, alone in a hospital, and didn't know where to go or who to call. I needed help. Several hours earlier, I was excitedly headed to Copper Mt. for a day of skiing when an icy patch in Castle Rock changed the day's plans for numerous people. I ended up in a snow-filled ditch after crashing into a vehicle. The paramedics found me unconscious and transported me to the Littleton Hospital for treatment. Because of the head trauma, I had to be released to someone. I did not know who to contact, so I started thinking about church family. My buddies were either skiing at a different time or headed home, and this was before cell phones were commonplace, so I couldn't have contacted them anyway! I called the Littleton Church of Christ, praying someone would pick up!

The secretary answered, and after explaining the situation, she replied there was someone who just might be available to help. He and his family responded generously by picking me up from the hospital, driving to the wrecked car lot to gather a few items, feeding me, letting me spend the night, and taking me to the airport the next day. Wouldn't you know it, small world, their daughter-in-law's mother had been our daughter's 1st-grade teacher at WCS.

Making the call was a humbling experience. Asking for help is not the easiest thing to do, but on the other hand, it was easy because that is what a church family is for. Praise God! He put somebody there to help, someone who had and was living the mindset of Jesus - we all need to live like Jesus!
