HAPPY FATHER'S DAY

I have been so blessed to have both a wonderful earthly father and an amazing Heavenly Father who have never failed to love and care for me. I am constantly reminded of the characteristics that my dad and God the Father have in common through their actions and presence in my life.

A month ago, I was traveling to Harding University for my best friend's wedding when I got stuck in the storm that hit Livingston, which ultimately flooded and shut down all the roads. Yes, I was stuck and surrounded by floodwaters, but I was also stuck next to a gas station, a grocery store, and a hotel in case I needed to stay there longer than expected. I discovered that even in the midst of a difficult situation, the Heavenly Father was still taking care of me, providing for me, and continuing to bless me through the people who were checking on me, including my dad and the encouraging advice he kept giving me. When I counted those blessings, I decided to turn towards God in a state of gratitude instead.

As I continued to thank God, I was also praying for Him to show me a safe way out. When my dad called to check on me again, I decided to check my phone one more time for a new alternative route that was considered safe. After 5 hours searching and waiting, I finally found a safe road that would lead me out of the flood! To bring me comfort as I drove, I stayed on the phone with my dad, and I asked God to keep me safe while He guided me down this new path. With the comfort of the Lord's spiritual presence, my dad's constant concern and encouragement, and their combined guidance, I was able to safely make it out of the storm!

Whether it be with my Heavenly Father or my earthly one, I was in constant contact with a caring father who was actively working to protect and guide me during a difficult situation. I thank God for blessing me with my earthly father who makes it a priority to guide and encourage me to grow closer to my Heavenly Father.
