ARE WE PREPARED?

I am amazed at the contents of a mother's purse. They seem to have everything one could imagine inside! They are ready for any emergency one of their children may have or that of anyone within viewing distance.

A mother's purse is packed with money, credit cards, library cards, punch cards that can be redeemed at an ice cream shop, medical information for each family member, and so much more. Of course, these things are only the back-ups for the information stored on the cell phone secured on the outside pocket.

A father's wallet may have most of these items, too, but the contents of mom's purse are far more numerous. She may also have napkins, facial tissues, paper towels, and wet wipes. If one near her would happen to get sick, she is prepared with aspirin, Tylenol, oils, Tums, and possibly a stethoscope. She stores grape jelly, packets of peanut butter, loose change, band aids, paper clips, pens, and, for some reason, often, one stray bobby pen in her purse. Many mothers are prepared for whatever situation they may face.
