BE THE VILLAGE

We are in no uncertain terms shaped by those who came before us. We are influenced by and often inherit our forebearers' knowledge, habits, and beliefs. Those who raise us imbue in us, intentionally or not, those things which they believe, which are often learned from those who came before them. And today we come together to recognize, pray over, and bless what is the latest, but please God not the last, in a long line of believers that spans back and deeply connects in faith and lineage through both Testaments all the way to Adam.

Traditional, first century Christianity in the community sense was very Eastern, very Jewish. It was focused not only on the nuclear family unit, but on the greater family of believers. It focused on loving, supporting, protecting, nurturing, and holding accountable all those who professed belief. Their shared identities of faith made them family in almost every sense of the word but biological, and their being washed in the blood of the lamb made their blood connection stronger even than birth and earthly lineage.

Many faith communities today have gotten away from that tight knit, family style community of faith and are simply church on Sunday mornings for an hour. But I want to challenge all of us today, on Baby Blessing Sunday, to strive our hardest to emulate that first century church in their sense of community and family. Do not just be a "Brother" or "Sister in Christ" in some empty sense of the word; rather, come alongside these new parents and truly become the family of Christ that we have all professed to be through our baptism.

I've never liked the phrase "It takes a village to raise a child," because to me it seems like it is passive, like it is waiting on someone else to step up and guard and guide the children in guestion. Like it is someone else's responsibility. Instead, it needs to be a call to action for each one of us, because all of these children are all of our responsibility. So today I challenge you: "It takes a village, be the village."

Baby Blessing will take place today at the end of services to honor all of our babies born in 2024.
