Family Center Update

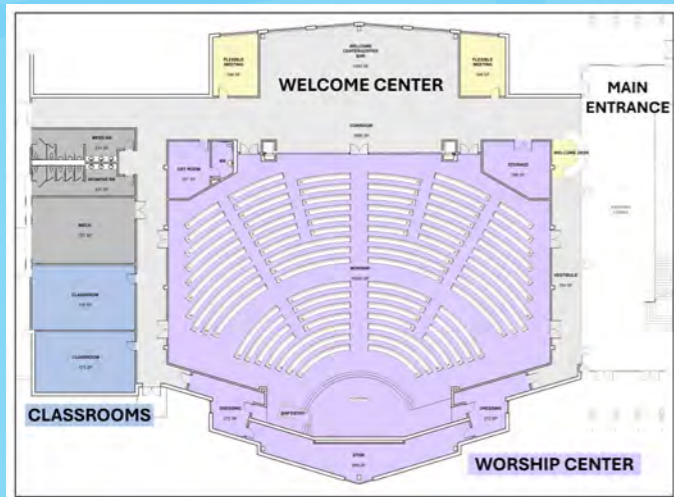
The Family Center, built in 1984, has served as a place for large gatherings, Bible classes, and community events, as well as the prime location serving Memorial's youth. The number of children at Memorial is growing, and the Memorial Kids, Bridge, and Youth ministries are flourishing.

The Master Plan envisions a remodeled space that is safe and inviting for our youth and provides a place for fellowship and service with updated kitchen and restroom facilities, refreshed classrooms, and indoor/outdoor space.



Worship Center

Education & Administration

The buildings on the north side of the campus house church offices, meeting rooms, adult classrooms, and Friendship School. Our Master Plan envisions a rebuild of this area of the campus, including:

- Additional adult classrooms to meet the needs of growing Bible classes and small group studies.
- A large flexible space, similar to our Oak View Room, to allow members to gather for seminars, receptions, meetings, luncheons, and other activities.
- Critical storage space for resources from office supplies to tablecloths to VBS props and supplies.
- Church offices that provide a welcoming environment to visitors and an efficient working environment for ministry staff.
- Friendship School facilities that allow teachers to continue to share the love of Jesus with the littlest and most important in God's kingdom and provide a strong foundation for children to grow in their faith.
