THE CROSS THROUGH RESURRECTION LENSES

Happy Memorial Day weekend. As you may know, the last Monday of May in the United States is designated as a time to remember the men and women of the military who died while serving their country.

The freedoms that the fallen men and women helped win for us are numerous. We appreciate their sacrifice because without them, our lives would have been completely different. We enjoy things such as freedom of speech, freedom to pursue the careers we desire, the freedom of due process in court.
