# **SERVANT HEARTS**

Many of us probably arrive on Sunday morning and never think about all the volunteers it takes for a Sunday of service and worship to occur. We know there should be a preacher, song leader and some people to say prayers, but we may never think of the rest.

Let us think for a moment about the people who give of their time. As you enter the building, there will be a handful of greeters at the door. At the other end of the foyer, you will see people bringing in donuts and others making coffee. There will be people volunteering at the welcome desk that not only answer questions, they prepare the translating devices for the people that will have the sermon transmitted into their own languages.

As you enter the auditorium, you may see the preacher, song leader, a couple of men who will lead us in prayer, a person to guide us through the Lord's Supper and a Scripture reader. If you look in the balcony, you will also see someone running the sound board, another handling the PowerPoint and yet, another, filming the service.

Other members also quietly share their talents that you may not see. A few people count people in the pews and others count the money that is put in the boxes. Others make the "busy bags" to help provide children with an outlet for their energy while they participate in worship. Still, others, will make sure there are communion supplies and bulletins available.

I haven't mentioned the Bible classes. The children's program has 56 volunteers each week to help in the classes and Bible Hour. Additionally, adult and youth teachers deliver lessons while others serve as class leaders.

By my count, there are at least 112 people working to make "Sunday" happen every week! First, it is wonderful to work with so many devoted volunteers. Please thank them for the work they do for us and dedicate to the Lord. Second, there are places for you to serve as well so that we can give these wonderful servants a deserved break occasionally.

I am grateful to work in a congregation with so many devoted Christians.
