THE PARADOX OF WEAKNESS

Read these lyrics from "Stained Glass Masquerade" by Casting Crowns.

Is there anyone that fails Is there anyone that falls Am I the only one in church today Feeling so small Because when I take a look around Everybody seems so strong I know they'll soon discover That I don't belong So I tuck it all away, like every thing's okay If I make them all believe it, maybe I'll believe it too

So with a painted grin, I play the part again So everyone will see me the way that I see them

Are we happy plastic people Under shiny plastic steeples With walls around our weakness And smiles to hide our pain? But if the invitation's open To every heart that has been broken Maybe then we close the curtain On our stained-glass masquerade

Do you relate to any of this? Have you known people who pretend like everything is great when the reality is much different? Before we get carried away by looking at the spec of sawdust elsewhere, let's consider the possible log in our own eye - Have you ever masked your struggle, pain, or sin? If you are like me, you have been there. If you are like me, you have been like Adam and Eve (Genesis 3) - trying to hide from God in your sin and your shame which only leads to more sin and greater shame. So why is this problematic?

But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore, I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me. That is why, for Christ's sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong.

In 2 Corinthians 12:9-10, Paul reminds us that God's strength meets us in our weakness, not in our perfection. By failing to acknowledge our weakness, we are missing out on the power and promise of God's grace. When we recognize and admit our weakness, the power of Christ shows up in our lives. So, ask yourself:

- 1. What "mask" do I tend to wear around others or before God?
- 2. What would change if I started being honest not just about my faith, but about my weakness?
- 3. How could my honesty help someone else experience God's grace?
