## **GODLY LAMENT**

It was September 11th when I saw that it was my turn to write the bulletin article. It was also a day after Charlie Kirk was assassinated and several days after Irina Zarutska was senselessly killed on a train and the Annunciation Catholic Church shooting killed two children. Without a doubt, my heart was and still is deeply wounded at all the meaningless violence and loss of life, whether it be almost 3,000 people over 20 years ago or the gratuitous violence against individuals in recent days. It has been an almost overwhelming few days of feeling loss, chaos, and lament in my heart. And it is more than ok that I feel those things.

Lament is something the modern church has lost sight of. We have forgotten that lament, when taken to God, is simply a prayer of pain. It is taking our sorrow and suffering and offering it up to the Lord as a true sacrifice. When we bring our broken hearts to the Lord, we sacrifice our pride, acknowledging that we cannot keep up with even the illusion that we are in control of our situation or our agony.

We are all made in the Image of God, and God himself does not shy away from lament. In Isaiah 1 and Hosea 11, the Lord laments the wickedness that has spread over the land of Israel. However, God does not just mourn those who choose to turn away from Him; He also mourns the pain, anguish, and even death of His children as inflicted upon them by others.

When God came to earth in the form of Christ, we see the Lord sob over Lazarus, His lost friend. When facing His own imminent death, Jesus retreated to Gethsemane to pray and ask for deliverance. Even on the cross, Christ cried out "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?" And God Himself rent the Temple curtain, just as one would rend their garments, to show extreme grief and sorrow at the loss of His son.

It is important to remember that lament is not just human, but it is biblical. Furthermore, it is godly. When we follow Christ's command in Matthew 11:28-29 to go to the Lord with our sorrows, we are following in the footsteps of Christ himself, who lamented at suffering and loss. May we all seek out God in our darkest moments, so that we can continue to be the light in the darkest corners of the world.
