# JUDGY MATTHEW 7:1-6 10/29/23

#### I. MISQUOTED PASSAGE

Matthew 7:1 - "Judge not, that you be not judged."

## 1. Standard by which we judge is God's Word (Truth)

2. Purpose of judging is to help people move from sin to holiness

## **II. THREE IDENTIFIERS OF A JUDGMENTAL HEART?**

### 1. Heart = Misunderstands Human Depravity

Matthew 7:2 - "For with the judgment you pronounce you will be judged, and with the measure you use it will be measured to you."

## ~ As sinful people we make horrible judges

#### 2. Heart = Lacks Self-awareness

Matthew 7:3 - "Why do you see the speck that is in your brother's eye, but do not notice the log that is in your own eye?"

### ~ We are blind to the effects of our sin

### 3. Heart = Full of Pride

Matthew 7:4 - "Or how can you say to your brother, 'Let me take the speck out of your eye,' when there is the log in your own eye?"

### ~ We have an inflated view of our own righteousness

### III. JESUS' STANDARD OF JUDGMENT

### 1. Calls us to brotherly responsibility

Matthew 7:5 - "You hypocrite, first take the log out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to take the speck out of your brother's eye."

### ~ "What's in you is in me too"

~ Born out of humility

### 2. Reminds us that Jesus is the only perfect Judge

John 3:17-18 - "For God did not send his Son into the world to judge the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him. <sup>18</sup> Whoever believes in him is not judged, but whoever does not believe is judged already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God."

## COMMUNITY GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. What did you think about the message this week? What stood out to you or challenged your thinking?
- 2. Why do you think the message of the world is to "never judge someone"? What does it communicate about our world that it avoids judgment?
- 3. Why is it so easy for us to become judgmental of others? What does it communicate about us that we do this?
- 4. What aspect of the way that God treated you in the Gospel should compel you to be humble with others?
- 5. Why is it important for us to see God as the perfect judge? Which of His many attributes makes Him a perfect judge?

**READ 1 CORINTHIANS 4:5** 

- 6. What does God do as a judge that we cannot in this verse? Why is it important for us to know how God will judge us?
- 7. We judge to get our commendation from men, but Paul tells us (in 1 Cor. 4:5) that if God judges, then He will also give the commendation. Which commendation is more meaningful and why?
- 8. If we do need to rightfully judge sin and falsehood... What would be some good things to do before you approach the issue?
- 9. Are we more sensitive to the sins of others than we are to our own sins? Why is this? How do we increase our awareness of our own sin?
- 10. How can right judgement help people move from sin to holiness?
