## I. TWO GATES - NARROW AND WIDE

## 1. The narrow gate is the Gospel (Good News) of Jesus

John 10:9-"I am the door. If anyone enters by me, he will be saved and will go in and out and find pasture."
John 14:6-"Jesus said to him, 'I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.'"
2. We are called to enter the gate, not admire the gate
3. The Narrow gate shows us that the Gospel is exclusive

## II. TWO WAYS - HARD AND EASY

1. Our flesh desires the easy road, but Jesus calls us to the hard road

Psalm 73:3-5 - "For I was envious of the arrogant when I saw the prosperity of the wicked. For they have no pangs until death; their bodies are fat and sleek. They are not in trouble as others are; they are not stricken like the rest of mankind."

Psalm 73:27-28 - "For behold, those who are far from you shall perish; you put an end to everyone who is unfaithful to you. But for me it is good to be near God; I have made the Lord GoD my refuge, that I may tell of all your works."

Matthew 16:24-26 - "Then Jesus told his disciples, 'If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me. ${ }^{25}$ For whoever would save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it. ${ }^{26}$ For what will it profit a man if he gains the whole world and forfeits his soul? Or what shall a man give in return for his soul?'"
2. The hard way is a life of dying to yourself

## 3. Discipleship is not easy or for the faint of heart

## III. TWO ETERNITIES - DESTRUCTION AND LIFE

1. The wide way promises happiness but delivers destruction
2. The narrow way promises to give us eternal hope
3. The narrow gate is open to everyone, but not everyone will find it
