PAUL AND THE CALL (Part 1) ROMANS 1:1-7 1/5/24

I. CONTEXT

- A. Claudius' edict expelled Jews from Rome
- B. The Church in Rome is fractured
- C. Paul writes for unity in the Gospel

II. WHO WAS PAUL?

A. A "servant"

- **1.** "Dulos" slave of Jesus Christ
- 2. Paul saw himself as the possession of Jesus Christ

1 Corinthians 6:20 - "For you were bought with a price. So, glorify God in your body"

B. God is unlike any sinful earthly master

Psalm 103:8 - "God is merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in Love"

C. Paul's whole life belonged fully to Christ

D. We are all slaves to something

- **1.** We were created as dependent beings
- 2. Anything we serve that is not God...is sin

Romans 6:16 - "Do you not know that if you present yourselves to anyone as obedient slaves, you are slaves of the one whom you obey, either of sin, which leads to death, or of obedience, which leads to righteousness?"

E. God is a good master because He served us

Philippians 2:5-8 - "Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, ⁶ who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, ⁷ but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. ⁸ And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross."
