# PAUL AND THE CALL (Part 2) ROMANS 1:1-7 1/12/25

## I. PAUL'S CALL

Romans 1:1 - "Paul, a servant of Christ Jesus, called to be an apostle, set apart for the gospel of God..."

#### A. "Called to be an Apostle"

- Declares his God given authority to the Church

## B. Paul's call as an Apostle was to proclaim the Gospel

## II. FIVE GOSPEL POINTS

## A. The Gospel is "of God"

Romans 1:1 - "Paul, a servant of Christ Jesus, called to be an apostle, set apart for the gospel of God..."

## B. The Gospel is fulfilled prophecy

Romans 1:2 - "...which he promised beforehand through his prophets in the holy Scriptures..."

## C. The Gospel is about the God/Man

Romans 1:3-4a - "…concerning his Son, who was descended from David according to the flesh <sup>4</sup> and was declared to be the Son of God…"

#### D. The Gospel is powered in the resurrection

Romans 1:4b - "...in power according to the Spirit of holiness by his resurrection from the dead, Jesus Christ our Lord..."

#### E. The Gospel centers on Jesus

Romans 1:5 - "...through whom we have received grace and apostleship to bring about the obedience of faith for the sake of his name among all the nations..."

#### III. CHURCH'S CALL

Romans 1:6-7 - "...including you who are called to belong to Jesus Christ,<sup>7</sup> to all those in Rome who are loved by God and called to be saints: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ."

- A. We are called to "belong to Jesus"
- B. We are called to "be saints"
- C. We are called in the same way Paul was
