# PUT OTHERS FIRST ROMANS 15:1-7 10/19/25

#### I. THE OBLIGATION

Romans 15:1-2 - "We who are strong have an obligation to bear with the failings of the weak, and not to please ourselves. <sup>2</sup> Let each of us please his neighbor for his good, to build him up."

### A. "Bear" with the weak

Assume the same burden they carry

## B. "Please" your neighbor

• We do this for their spiritual good

#### II. THE EXAMPLE

Romans 15:3 - "For Christ did not please himself, but as it is written, 'The reproaches of those who reproached you fell on me."

#### Jesus

Philippians 2:5-8 – "Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, <sup>6</sup> who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, <sup>7</sup> but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. <sup>8</sup> And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross."

## III. THE ENCOURAGEMENT

Romans 15:4 - "For whatever was written in former days was written for our instruction, that through endurance and through the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope."

#### Scripture

- 1. Scripture is written for "instruction"
- 2. We should endure in Scripture
- 3. Scripture produces "hope"

### IV. THE PRAYER

Romans 15:5-7 - "May the God of endurance and encouragement grant you to live in such harmony with one another, in accord with Christ Jesus, <sup>6</sup> that together you may with one voice glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. <sup>7</sup> Therefore welcome one another as Christ has welcomed you, for the glory of God."

### A. "Harmony"/Unity

• This unity is "in accordance with Jesus"

### B. Worship

• Purpose of worship is God's glory

- 1. What did you think about the message this week? What stood out to you or challenged your thinking?

- 7. Why do you think a unified church is so important to Paul and the New Testament writers? How does a unified church glorify God's name?
- 8. In v.5 Paul asks God to create unity in the church. What does this tell us about how we should pursue unity? How have you seen God accomplish unity in a church setting?
- 9. What is one thing from the message or the group this week that you would like to live out? How can the group help you in accomplishing that?
