I. BAD PRACTICE EXPOSED

Matthew 6:7 - "And when you pray, do not heap up empty phrases as the Gentiles do..."

~ Jesus pointed to an example in the current culture when explaining what prayer should be like.

II. BAD REASONING EXPOSED

Matthew 6:7 - "...for they think that they will be heard for their many words."

~ Cultural norms have the potential to impact us in 2 different ways:

- A. The way we think
- B. The way we behave

III. BAD BELIEF EXPOSED

Matthew 6:8 - "...for your Father knows what you need before you ask him."

"Prayer is not informing God of something He does not already know. Nor is prayer seeking to get God to change His mind. It is the adoring submission of the creature to the Creator, of the disciple to the Master." - Michael Green
