HABAKKUK 2

*Habakkuk 2:1 - "I will take my stand at my watch post and station myself on the tower, and look out to see what he will say to me, and what I will answer concerning my complaint."*

**I. HABAKKUK'S POSITION**

~ **Watching and waiting on the Lord**

**II. GOD ANSWERS**

*Habakkuk 2:2 - "And the LORD answered me: 'Write the vision; make it plain on tablets, so he may run who reads it.'"*

**A. His response is gentle and gracious**

**B. Make the vision clear so everyone can understand it**

*Habakkuk 2:3 - "For still the vision awaits its appointed time; it hastens to the end—it will not lie. If it seems slow, wait for it; it will surely come; it will not delay."*

*Habakkuk 2:4 - "Behold, his soul is puffed up; it is not upright within him, but the righteous shall live by his faith."*

**III. TWO WAYS**

**A. Way of PRIDE**

1. Pride is a cancerous "tumor" to our souls
2. Ultimate pride – making ourselves a god

~ We desire control

**B. Way of FAITH**

1. Justified (declared righteous) by faith

*Romans 3:28 - "For we hold that one is justified by faith apart from works of the law."*

2. Sanctified (become Christlike) by faith

*Romans 10:17 - "So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ."*

3. Our faith is not blind if we have God's Word

**IV. GOD'S PLAN**

**A. He will judge wicked Babylon**

**B. God's hidden purposes**

*Habakkuk 2:14 - "For the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the LORD as the waters cover the sea."*

**C. God was using the captivity to make Himself known to the ENTIRE earth**

9. In Habakkuk 2:14 God was going to make Himself known in the Earth through the captivity. How has God used difficulty in your life to make more of Himself known to you or others?
10. Knowing that God can use difficulty to glorify His name...how does this encourage you as you face difficulty?
