GATEWAY TO THE PSALMS PSALM 1 6/2/24

I. CONTEXT OF THE PSALMS

- A. The Psalms are organized, not a random collection
- B. Psalms convey the deepest and rawest of emotions

II. DO'S AND DON'TS

Psalm 1:1-2 - "Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of scoffers; but his delight is in the law of the Lord, and on his law he meditates day and night."

A. DON'T

- 1. "Walk, Stand, Sit" in wickedness
- 2. Shows a gradual decline

B. DO

- 1. Delight in God's word
- 2. Meditate on God's word

III. TWO OUTCOMES

Psalm 1:3-4 - "He is like a tree planted by streams of water that yields its fruit in its season, and its leaf does not wither. In all that he does, he prospers. ⁴The wicked are not so, but are like chaff that the wind drives away."

A. A Life devoted to God has...

- 1. Roots
 - ~ Not moved by false teaching or doctrine
- 2. Fruits
 - ~ Product of a transformed life

B. A Life apart from God (wicked)

- 1. Chaff
 - ~ Driven by the wind...unstable

IV. TWO DESTINIES

Psalm 1:5-6 - "Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous; ⁶ for the Lord knows the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked will perish."

- A. Wicked will not stand in judgment
- B. Righteous "Known" by God
 - 1. Known = Covenant, Relational and Intimate knowledge

COMMUNITY GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. What did you think about the message this week? What stood out to you or challenged your thinking?
- 2. What things/people are negatively impacting the ways in which we walk today? Why is it important to acknowledge and understand the nature of these things?
- 3. What does delight in God's Word look like? What things rob us from delighting and meditating in God's Word?
- 4. What will happen if we try to obey God's commands without first delighting and meditating in His Word?
- 5. How would being more rooted in God's word affect your life, job, your family, your community?
- 6. How does God's intimate knowledge of you encourage you in your prayer life?
- 7. What is one practical application from the sermon that you want to implement this week?

PRAY THE PSALM

- As a group read through the Psalm again and pray the Psalm back to the Lord!
- Here are some ideas of what to pray from Psalm 1...
 - Thank God for His word (v.2)
 - o Pray that God would help you take delight in His word (v.2)
 - o Pray that God would keep you wise to the way of wickedness (v.1)
 - o Pray that God would root you with a strong foundation on His word (v.3)
 - Pray for God to produce fruit in your life (v.3)
 - o Thank God that He "knows" the way of the righteous (v.6)
