Psalm 42 6/23/24

I. The Thirst

Psalm 42:1-2 – "As a deer pants for flowing streams, so pants my soul for you, O God. ² My soul thirsts for God, for the living God. When shall I come and appear before God?"

II. The Tears

Psalm 42:3-4 – "My tears have been my food day and night, while they say to me all the day long, 'Where is your God?' ⁴These things I remember, as I pour out my soul: how I would go with the throng and lead them in procession to the house of God with glad shouts and songs of praise, a multitude keeping festival."

III. The Gospel

Psalm 42:5-6 – "Why are you cast down, O my soul, and why are you in turmoil within me? Hope in God; for I shall again praise him, my salvation ⁶ and my God. My soul is cast down within me; therefore I remember you from the land of Jordan and of Hermon, from Mount Mizar."

IV. The Deep

Psalm 42:7-8 – "Deep calls to deep at the roar of your waterfalls; all your breakers and your waves have gone over me.
By day the Lord commands his steadfast love, and at night his song is with me, a prayer to the God of my life."

V. The Repeat

Psalm 42:9-11- "I say to God, my rock: 'Why have you forgotten me? Why do I go mourning because of the oppression of the enemy?' ¹⁰ As with a deadly wound in my bones, my adversaries taunt me, while they say to me all the day long, 'Where is your God?' ¹¹ Why are you cast down, O my soul, and why are you in turmoil within me? Hope in God; for I shall again praise him, my salvation and my God."

2 Corinthians 5:21 - "For our sake He made Him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in Him we might become the righteousness of God."

COMMUNITY GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. What did you think about the message this week? What stood out to you or challenged your thinking?
- 2. Review the truths we covered Sunday.
- 3. Read Psalm 42. What does the Psalmist remember in his times of trouble?
- 4. Read Psalm 42:2, 5b, and 6. How does he describe God? Why is it important to daily preach the Gospel (who God is and what He does) to ourselves?
- 5. What is the role of the community of believers in helping someone who is discouraged? How does Psalm 42:4 inform your answer in how we can bless each other? (See also Hebrews 10:24-25)
- 6. Pray Psalm 42 for someone.

PRAYING THE PSALM

- Pray that your longing for God would ever grow
- Pray that God would satisfy your soul unlike anything else
- Praise God that He is a "living God" (v.2) who hears our cries
- Pray that your hope in God would increase even in difficult circumstances
- Thank God that when we are downcast, He gives us great hope!
