# PRAYING FOR ABOUNDING LOVE PHILIPPIANS 1:9-11 9-22-24

### I. PRAY FOR ABOUNDING LOVE

# A. Increasing means we have not arrived

Not even Paul

Philippians 3:12-14 - "Not that I have already obtained this or am already perfect, but I press on to make it my own, because Christ Jesus has made me his own. <sup>13</sup> Brothers, I do not consider that I have made it my own. But one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, <sup>14</sup> I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus."

## B. Abounding in love for God

• Any love for God that is not expressed in a love for others is a false love!

1 John 4:7-8 - "Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God. <sup>8</sup> Anvone who does not love does not know God, because God is love."

#### C. We must ORDER OUR LOVES

## II. HOW DOES LOVE ABOUND?

Philippians 1:9 – "And it is my prayer that your love may abound more and more, with knowledge and all discernment..."

- A. Love abounds with knowledge (v.9a)
- B. Love abounds with discernment (v.9b)

## III. RESULT OF LOVE ABOUNDING

Philippians 1:10 – "...so that you may approve what is excellent, and so be pure and blameless for the day of Christ, <sup>11</sup> filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God."

- A. We approve what is Excellent (v.10a)
- **B.** We are Pure and Blameless (v.10b)
  - Filled with Fruit (v.11)

Galatians 5:22 - "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, <sup>23</sup> gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law."

#### C. God is Glorified in the Church
