

October 6 through November 3 2024


During October, Pastor Linda's sermon series will be Wesley Rooted.

Community Connection

Our September mission moment is <u>Springboard</u>, which serves young adults who leave foster care at 18 and may face homelessness or neglect. Springboard provides quality housing, mentorship, and the necessary tools, including life skills training and therapeutic services, to support long-term independence. They serve clients through age 22 and require that all residents must be in school or work full-time. Their stated goal is "to prevent young adults from becoming negative statistics by providing the stepping stones they need to lead positive, productive, and independent lives."

Items that would be useful to these young adults include:

cleaning products
toiletries (including feminine hygiene products,
toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo and conditioner,
deodorants, dental floss, etc.)
laundry detergent
paper towels
toilet paper
Clorox wipes
