Pastor's Note

One the wonderful worship events of the year occurs on Christmas Eve. The joy of the evening as Christ's family gathers to welcome him home is like no other. And it is a time to welcome home many friends and family who can't often make worship on a regular basis. During Advent, my sermon series has been 'Journey to the Nativity.' On Christmas Eve we will conclude that journey with a 'Welcome Home' theme. Christmas holiday is often one in which family gather together to warm greetings of Welcome Home! On Christmas Eve that same greeting will be heard as we welcome others but also Jesus into our heart once again.

Some people struggle with the idea of welcoming the Christ child on Christmas Eve. Jesus has been here, why are we acting like this night is a new event all over again? For me Christmas is not just a time of remembering Jesus' birthday, but it is a time to open our hearts back up to Jesus. Who: Everyone is invited! Children's Birthday time and singing of Christmas music for all.



The Florida United Methodist Children's Home was first established in 1908 as the Florida Methodist Orphanage. Since that time it has grown into a multifaceted organization serving abused, abandoned, and neglected children from across the state of Florida. In addition to providing a higher level of therapeutic residential care in two locations, they also provide foster care and outpatient counseling in multiple counties. They realized that they had outgrown the Children's Home name, and needed something that better represented the purpose we serve and the care we provide. That new name is Residing Hope.

The local church is the veritable backbone of everything that happens at Residing Hope beginning in 1906 when local Methodist Churches began collecting Fifth Sunday offerings. Those Fifth Sunday offerings have become part of the fabric of support by the local churches here in Florida and continue to bless our ministry.
