

Centering Prayer is a Christian method of meditation based on the teachings and practice of Jesus. It is a contemporary version of an ancient practice. It is ecumenical and inter-faith friendly. Based on faith, hope, and love, it is not in competition with any other method of prayer.



The workshop will consist of four Conferences: Prayer as Relationship, The Method, Thoughts and Use of the Sacred Word, Deepening Your Practice. There will be two periods to practice Centering Prayer.


I am no longer my own, but yours.
