	Church Yard Sale – help with annual event to raise funds for local charities, youth groups, missions etc.
	Coffeehouse for Special Needs Adults – a monthly social event for adults with special needs on the 2 nd Friday of each month. Volunteers set up, greet guests, serve refreshments, and clean up.
	Habitat for Humanity – Volunteer as part of a team in home construction for families in need.
	Human Care Committee – partnering with several local agencies to provide support. Volunteers are needed for year-round special events and collections, such as Operation Inasmuch, etc.
	Cross-Cultural Mission Engagement Team – assist RLC in bringing the Gospel of Jesus Christ across boundaries of language and culture, both in our own community and abroad.
	Outreach to the Blind – a monthly fellowship dinner for those who are blind or visually impaired. Volunteers provide transportation, prepare and serve food to guests, and help set up and clean up.
	Prayer Shawl Ministry – Make shawls to give to people in need of comfort.
	Quilters (Lutheran World Relief) – make handmade quilts for service organizations – currently Sleep in Heavenly Peace and Lutheran World Relief.
	Read A Book-Get A Book – program offering one-on-one support to boost literacy in the public schools
	Safe Families for Children – creates extended family-like supports for desperate families through devoted volunteers who are motivated by faith to keep children safe and families intact.
	Sleep in Heavenly Peace – builds beds for families who do not have the means to provide beds for their children.

	Altar/Sacristy Care – Caring for the altar linens and preparing for the Sacraments of Communion and Baptism. Sacristy volunteers maintain the car of worship assistant and acolyte robes.

	Ushers – Helping to greet and serve people during the worship service and to assist any guests.
	Worship Assistant – Assist in serving communion and other aspects of managing details of worship.
