_____ **Resurrection Prayer Community** – Members meet weekly to pray specifically for requests RLC receives via worship services, phone calls or the website.

_____ **Resurrection Service Project** – Assist elderly, infirmed, those in financial difficulty and others in our congregation & community with home maintenance and repairs.

_____ **Stephen Ministry** – Trained lay leaders who offer confidential one-on-one care to a person in need.

- _____ **Children's Church** – 20 minute ministry for children during the sermon time at the 11:00 am service. Lessons & supplies are provided.
- _____ **K.I.C.K.S. and/or Kidz Live** (Grades 3-5) – Assist with events behind the scenes or in person.
- _____ **Nursery** – Adult volunteers and youth ages 12+ provide childcare for infants and toddlers during worship services or other scheduled church events.
- _____ **Rainbow Bags** – Clean, assemble, sort items (supplies provided).

- _____ **Chair Team** – Set up & tear down of worship seating for the 11am worship service.
- _____ **Church/Grounds Maintenance** – Skills of all types are needed to help with regularly scheduled or special projects including carpentry, computer, electrical, plumbing, painting, roofing, gardening and landscaping.
- _____ **Counting** – Count church offerings from weekend worship services.

- _____ **Resurrection Lutheran Preschool/School/Music** – Serving or participating in the activities of the school in the office, classroom, or on a board or committee.

Service to the Community Ministry Opportunities

- _____ **Church Yard Sale** – help with annual event to raise funds for local charities, youth groups, missions etc.
- _____ **Coffeehouse for Special Needs Adults** – a monthly social event for adults with special needs on the 2nd Friday of each month. Volunteers set up, greet guests, serve refreshments, and clean up.
- _____ **Habitat for Humanity** – Volunteer as part of a team in home construction for families in need.
- _____ **Human Care Committee** – partnering with several local agencies to provide support. Volunteers are needed for year-round special events and collections, such as Operation Inasmuch, etc.
- _____ **Cross-Cultural Mission Engagement Team** – assist RLC in bringing the Gospel of Jesus Christ across boundaries of language and culture, both in our own community and abroad.
- _____ **Outreach to the Blind** – a monthly fellowship dinner for those who are blind or visually impaired. Volunteers provide transportation, prepare and serve food to guests, and help set up and clean up.
- _____ **Prayer Shawl Ministry** – Make shawls to give to people in need of comfort.
- _____ **Quilters** (Lutheran World Relief) – make handmade quilts for service organizations – currently Sleep in Heavenly Peace and Lutheran World Relief.
- _____ **Read A Book-Get A Book** – program offering one-on-one support to boost literacy in the public schools
- _____ **Safe Families for Children** – creates extended family-like supports for desperate families through devoted volunteers who are motivated by faith to keep children safe and families intact.
- _____ **Sleep in Heavenly Peace** – builds beds for families who do not have the means to provide beds for their children.

- _____ **Altar/Sacristy Care** – Caring for the altar linens and preparing for the Sacraments of Communion and Baptism. Sacristy volunteers maintain the care of worship assistant and acolyte robes.

- _____ **Worship Assistant** – Assist in serving communion and other aspects of managing details of worship.
