Getting Started

- How has God been working in your life in the last few weeks?
 - Is there an area where you feel discouraged?
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Sermon Discussion

- What are some reasons we can begin to feel like we are in a valley of hopelessness?
 - What does it mean to you that God doesn't fix circumstances, He restores hearts?
 - In what ways can someone be busy, successful, or religious yet still feel spiritually dry?
 - Why do we tend to define ourselves and others by our current conditions instead of God's potential?
 - Ezekiel had to speak God's word before he saw change. What does this teach us about faith and obedience?
 - What are practical ways we can "speak life" into dry situations?
 - Why is it so hard to believe that God can restore something that has been "dead" for so long?
 - Why do we sometimes give up on people looking at them as "dry bones"? Who in your life might God be asking you to stop giving up on?
 - What does true life look like? Why is it that only God's Spirit can bring it about?
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This Week's Action Response

- Nobody is ever too “dry”. The Word of God and the Spirit of God can resurrect anyone that is dead in their sin. If you in a season of despair, dive into God’s Word and pray that His Spirit will renew you. If you know someone in that season, pray for opportunities to share the Word of God with them.
