

Tri-Village Sermon Discussion Questions

Topic: A Promise Without Limits Service Date(s): April 14, 2024 Acts 2:37-41

Note: The questions are only a starting point for discussion. Don't hesitate to modify, adapt, or highlight only specific ones to fit your group and/or personal study.

Getting Started

- What is something that you not only get excited about but also enjoying talking to others about?
- What, specifically, excites you about *The Promise* Campaign?

Sermon Discussion

- If someone asked you why you think Tri-Village is growing, what would your response be? Do you find yourself excited? Why or why not?
- Acts 2:39 says, "The promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off- for all whom the Lord our God will call." In thinking about not only our life but those you care about, why is this promise (of salvation through Jesus) something that should excite us?
- Why should *The Promise* Campaign matter to you and be important to us as a congregation?
- Think about your faith walk. Can you identify someone who encouraged you in your faith walk? Share about this person. What example did they give in helping you understand the importance of then encouraging others in their faith walk?
- A major part of celebrating and continuing the promise is an invitation- an invite to church, an event, a conversation, etc. What are some steps in your own life that need to happen in order that you can live in faith and share the "promise" with others?

- If you haven't extended invitations to attend church to a friend or neighbor that you know doesn't attend anywhere regularly or maybe not at all, what is preventing you from opening the door to this invitation?
- The Promise (Acts 2:39) implies that hope is for every generation. In thinking about your own spiritual legacy in relation to the campaign, what are you praying will happen?
- Optional <u>Group Activity</u>: *The Promise* campaign brings with it so many positive ways in which we can make an eternal difference. We're looking to have as many individuals as possible share on video 1-2 sentences about what excites them regarding *The Promise* campaign. No need to get fancy-you can have a member of your group record each person on their phone. Then, after recording, videos can be uploaded to tri-village.org/promisepromoter. In sharing, you'll have the opportunity to help spur others on in their faith through a collaborative video we're putting together.
