

Tri-Village Sermon Discussion Questions

Topic: Responding to God's Call in Faith
Text: Exodus 4:1-5
Service Date: May 19, 2024

Note: The questions are only a starting point for discussion. Don't hesitate to modify, adapt, or highlight only specific ones to fit your group and/or personal study.

Getting Started

- Everyone who calls Tri-Village their church home has had someone impact them in their spiritual life and helped bring them to this point. Who is/are those people in your life?
- Paul discussed how Tri-Village has helped change the lives of people. As you look back, how has your life, or the life of your family, been changed by being at Tri-Village?
- Is there someone you know that could be growing spiritually with a little encouragement? What's holding you back from helping them in their spiritual walk?

Sermon Discussion

- Each person has priorities in their life. If you were to look at your calendar and bank account today, what would you say are the top priorities and why?
- The sermon pointed out priorities and the difficulty in keeping them straight. What's the most effective way you have found to keep your priorities in line?
- Tangible expressions of love we are reminded of Mary, sister to Lazarus, who poured out the entire bottle of perfume on Jesus' feet as an act of affection. While it may not have been a bottle of perfume, share ways that you have either shown or been the recipient of a tangible expression of love. How does that example reflect Jesus?
- Is expressing tangible acts of love difficult? Why or why not?

- The sermon referenced Moses' staff and what is in our hand. What do you consider to be in your hand that you aren't using to bring people closer to Jesus?
- When we shift our focus from "what we can do *for* God" to "what we can do *with* God", doors open and lives are changed. He promises to be with us. Is there something standing in your way that you've tried to tackle on our own but need a reminder that God is WITH you in this endeavor or challenge?
- This summer, what is something you are sensing God calling you to do in faith that you just need to trust Him in doing? What steps are you going to take in order to make it happen?
