# What Are Your Teens' Post-Secondary Plans?

The VIBE Ministry, led by Elder Mark Richard, aims to support the spiritual growth, development, character building, and essential life skills of the teens and youth while "building the next generation of believers." One objective is to educate teens on financial principles for achieving generational wealth and maintaining a debt-free future. Reducing debt in all areas can lead to financial freedom and increase opportunities.

Did you know the average cost of four years at a public college is \$160,000? Imagine having that amount of money to support your family, help others, give back to the community and to invest. VIBE is sponsoring **Career and College** workshops to prepare students holistically for making the best fit post-secondary decision and ease future financial burden on families. These resources help families prepare well-rounded teens for their future, whether they choose to enroll in college, enlist in the military, or join the workforce. Teens will develop, implement, and evaluate a college and career road map to become responsible and independent adults inspired to give back to others.

Parents and teens will focus on organization, communication, personal development, commitment, character, extracurricular activities, finances, goals, lifestyle, integrity, spirituality, and work ethics. Families engage in career and college research, networking, team building, essay writing and applying for careers, colleges, and scholarships to aim for a debt-free degree.

Make plans to join engaging activities at our 2025 informational sessions, held on Saturdays from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., with unique topics covered on each date: **May 17<sup>th</sup>**, **June 14<sup>th</sup>**, and **September 20<sup>th</sup>**. Since 2019, this systematic approach has prepared high school students for making the best fit post-secondary decisions, secure admissions to colleges, and earn numerous scholarships, including full rides. During the 2023-2024 school term, a total of 81 participated, 45 parents and 36 students. Eight graduates received admission offers to more than twenty different colleges nationally and chose to enroll, collectively earned a total of **\$2.2 million** in scholarships. 





## Autism Awareness Month Spotlight: Honoring VIBE Ambassador Joshua Woods







At VIBE at Brookland — the youth and teen ministry of Brookland Baptist Church — while building the Next Generation of Believers, we believe in celebrating the unique gifts and powerful voices of every young person in our community. This Autism Awareness Month, we are especially proud to shine a spotlight on one of our very own: **Joshua Woods**, a devoted VIBE Ambassador, servant leader, and autism advocate. A senior at Westwood High School in Blythewood, South Carolina, Joshua is a consistent honor roll student with a 3.424 GPA (4.025 weighted). He has been accepted to Johnson & Wales University — Charlotte Campus, where he plans to major in Baking and Pastry/Culinary Arts — a passion he's excited to pursue. His leadership and academic excellence were recognized with the 2025 Columbia Urban League Youth and Gifted Award for Academic and Leadership Achievement.

Joshua is deeply engaged in both church and school life. At Brookland, he is one of the most consistent and committed students in the Christian Learning Studio (Sunday School). He has served as a Junior Usher since 2016 and actively contributes to the Youth and Teens Day Committee (VIBE Ambassadors) and the VIBE Ambassadors Activity & Interior Design Team — helping bring creativity and fun to youth ministry events.

At school, Joshua is equally involved. He serves as Subcommittee Chair of the National Society of Black Engineers Jr., is Founder and Chair of the Cornhole Club, and participates in the R2i2 Esports Club — all while maintaining his academic standing.

In the community, Joshua gives back through volunteer efforts including serving meals at Transitions Homeless Center, assisting with donation drives, and supporting the Brookland Baptist Blood Drive in partnership with the American Red Cross.
