

On the first Sunday in February, February 1, 2026 I will observe my 55th Pastor's Anniversary as servant-leader of the Brookland Church. For 55 years I have tried to serve as an under shepherd of God's people with unwavering faith, steadfast commitment and a loving heart. Through seasons of joy and sorrow, growth and change, I have tried to preach God's word with conviction, share God's vision with humility, lead the flock of God with integrity and model Christ-like love and compassion for all.

A number of persons have come to me wanting to celebrate this major milestone in Pastoral Ministry of 55 years with a Friday evening banquet featuring a national recording artist and a Sunday afternoon 55 year Anniversary Service. However, President Pamela Alford and our Church Aide Ministry understand I would prefer otherwise.

Fourteen years ago God gave us a vision for the next generation of young pastors, preachers and church leaders. Ribbon cutting marks reopening of Harold White Human Development Center



Local dignitaries cut the ribbon on the Harold White Human Development Center.

Community leaders, residents, and supporters gathered on December 18, 2025, as the Brookland-Lakeview Empowerment Center (BLEC) hosted a ribbon-cutting ceremony celebrating the reopening of the Harold White Human Development Center following years of extensive renovations.

During the ceremony, BLEC formally acknowledged and thanked the donors and partners whose support made the restoration possible. Recognized contributors included the National Park Service, the Lexington County Community Development Block Grant, and a number of individual and corporate donors and partners, including but not limited to Jumper Carter Sease Architects, TD Bank, Brookland Baptist Church, Dr. Charles B. Jackson, Sr., Dr. Charles B. Jackson, Jr., Dr. Rudy and Corliss Wise, Mr. Donny Burkett, Mr. Reginald Rearden, and Deacon Dennis and Bernice Breeland.

The long-anticipated reopening marks the completion of a multi-phase restoration effort aimed at revitalizing the historic center and expanding its ability to serve the community. Renovations included roofing restoration, interior and exterior painting, upgraded lighting, new bleachers, new basketball goals, new metal doors, and the installation of

translucent panels to allow for natural light throughout the facility. Most of the renovations were completed by M.E. Contracting, whose work played a significant role in bringing the multi-phase restoration project to completion.

The renovations were completed in three phases over the past five years through funding and support from the Lexington County Community Development Block Grant, the National Park Service, and committed individual and corporate donors.

Community officials praised the collaborative effort, emphasizing the center's renewed role as a hub for recreation, education, and community engagement.

"The reopening of this center is not just about a building—it's about preserving history, honoring excellence, and investing in the future of our community," said Dr. Cindye Richburg Cotton, executive director of the Brookland-Lakeview Empowerment Center.

The center is named in honor of Harold White, a trail-blazer in education and athletics whose career spanned more than four decades. Born in Columbia to the late Thomas A. White and Rosetta Edwards White, White was the sixth of seven children and a 1958 graduate of C.A. Johnson High School. He earned his degree

from South Carolina State College, now South Carolina State University, in 1963.

White began his professional career at Robert Smalls Junior High School in Beaufort before returning to the Midlands in 1964 to teach and coach at Lakeview High School in West Columbia. He later returned to C.A. Johnson High School, where he taught and coached football, and went on to serve as director of student activities at Benedict College.

In 1971, White made history as the first African American coach at the University of South Carolina. He later served as an academic counselor and retired in 2007 as senior associate athletic director, leaving a lasting legacy of leadership, mentorship, and barrier-breaking achievement.

With renovations complete, the Harold White Human Development Center is positioned to once again serve as a cornerstone for youth development, athletics, and community programming—honoring the life and legacy of the man whose name it proudly bears.

BEST OATMEAL RAISIN COOKIES

"This is a family favorite that I have been making for years. It's the most requested oatmeal cookie recipe I've ever made. I found it somewhere years ago, but have lost the source. The secret is soaking the raisins which makes all the difference."



Ready In: 1hr 10mins

M Ingredients: 12


Tields: 48 cookies

DIRECTIONS

- This is a very important first step that makes the cookie: combine eggs, raisins and vanilla and let stand for one hour.
- 2. Cream together butter and sugars.
- Add flour, salt, cinnamon and soda and mix well.
- Blend in egg-raisin mixture, oatmeal, and chopped nuts.
- 5. Dough will be stiff.
- Drop by heaping teaspoons onto ungreased cookie sheet, or roll into balls and flatten slightly.
- Bake at 350 degrees for 10 to 12 minutes or until lightly browned.

INGREDIENTS

- 3 eggs, well beaten
- 1 cup raisins
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 1 cup butter
- 1 cup brown sugar
- 1 cup white sugar
- $2\frac{1}{2}$ cups flour
 - 1 teaspoon salt
 - 1 teaspoon cinnamon
 - 2 teaspoons baking soda
 - 2 cups oatmeal
- 3/4 cup chopped pecans
