President Clinton signed the first NFC Month Presidential Proclamation in 1997 and every president since has followed suit by issuing an annual proclamation recognizing and honoring family caregivers each November.

A healing Journey

The Strength, Peace, and Hope Found in Prayer Jesus is the same yesterday, today, and forever (Hebrews 13:8). The same God who touched the sick and restored the broken is still at work in our lives today. Kingsley's healing journey is a testament that He heals our bodies, renews our minds, and restores our spirits.

"Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God." (Philippians 4:6). One of the most powerful gifts God has given us is prayer. It is more than words spoken; it is a sacred connection between us and the Creator. In prayer, we find strength when we are weak, peace when our hearts are troubled, and hope when life feels uncertain. Scripture reminds us that prayer is not only a privilege but also a lifeline that sustains and empowers us in every season of life. He answers us as he promised in many unique ways Jeremiah 33:6.

Strength in Prayer, Our endurance to life's challenges can be overwhelming from time to time. In those moments, prayer strengthens us by drawing us closer to God, the source of all power. Isaiah 40:29 declares, "He gives power to the faint; and to them that have no might he increases strength." Through prayer, we lean on God's strength instead of our own ability, which are immensely limited.

The Apostle Paul echoed this truth when he said, "I can do all things through Christ which strengthened me" (Philippians 4:13). Prayer allows us to surrender our burdens, receive divine encouragement, and continue pressing forward even when the road seems difficult. Some days are harder than others, but leaning on Christ's strength through prayer, makes each day possible.

Remember, Healing is a gift of grace, not something we can earn, but something Christ freely gives. Kingsley and I held onto this gift and daily our strength rises.

Peace in Prayer In a world filled with noise, chaos, and anxiety, prayer offers a quiet refuge for the soul. We look forward to every opportunity to pray even with tears that sometimes does not stop flowing. Philippians 4:6-7 teaches, "Be careful about nothing; but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. And the peace of God, which passes all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus." This promise assures us that prayer doesn't just change circumstances, it changes us. The peace of God calms our fears, eases our anxieties, and steadies our hearts in these uncertain periods. Prayer is a hiding place where we are safely secured and protected from the noise in our circumstances.

Hope in Prayer, Prayer also gives us hope, reminding us that no matter how dark the night, God's light will always shine through. Jeremiah 29:11 reassures us, "For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the Lord, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end." Hope is not rooted in our situations but in God's faithfulness. Through prayer, we are reminded that He is working on all things for our good (Romans 8:28). Even when answers are delayed or the complete manifestation of the promised healing is delayed, prayer helps us trust that God's timing is perfect and His promises are sure. That's hopeful!

Our hope through daily communion proclaims Christ's victory over sin, sickness, and death. His body was broken so that we might be made whole; His blood was shed so that we might have life. And not just have life but have it in abundance. This daily practice has established Kingsley and I and solidify our hope as blood bought children of God.


Living a Life of Prayer, Prayer is not just an emergency call in times of trouble but a daily discipline that deepens our relationship with God. 1 Thessalonians 5:17 encourages us to "pray without ceasing." This does not mean being on our knees all day but cultivating an attitude of constant communication with God. Whether in moments of joy, grief, or waiting, prayer keeps our hearts aligned with His will and fills us with unshakable confidence in His love.

Conclusion, In reality, strength, peace, and hope are not found in worldly possessions or achievements, rather in the presence of God accessed through prayer. When life's battles seem overwhelming, prayer anchors us in His promises, calms our troubled minds, and renews our hope for tomorrow. Truly, prayer is the key to walking victoriously in faith, no matter what challenges life may bring. Our prayer circle includes our family, our brothers and sisters in Christ, communities and friends. We are still here because of prayer. "We came by prayer, we will live in prayer, and when we leave this world, we will leave by prayer"






