Chapter 10

The Plagues Continue

Verses 10: 1-15 – The 8th plague – Locusts

God’s work was not only for the sake of Moses and Pharoah; it was also for their children and grandchildren. God does mighty works among us and for us to encourage generations to come. Pride was at the heart of Pharoah’s problem. He simply didn’t want to give into God.

God showed Himself greater than the Egyptian god “Osiris.” He was supposed to be the protector of crops. God again shows Pharoah and the Egyptians that there is only **ONE God**, the **LORD GOD JEHOVAH**.

Verses 10: 16-20 Another False repentance by Pharoah.

Pharoah did the same thing in these verses as he did in Exodus 9: 27-28. He said the words of repentance but did not follow through with the actions. His heart was only hardened more after God relented and showed mercy.

Verses 10: 21-29 - The ninth plague: Darkness

In Egypt, the sun was worshiped as the god of light. For there to be 3 days of darkness was for their source of light and heat to be cancelled. This was solid proof that the God who created the sun was mightier than the sun. The judgement against the sun gave plain evidence to Pharaoh and Egypt that they were now being abandoned by the God of Moses and Aaron. The darkness was so thick that the Egyptians could not see one another, neither move from one place to another. On the other hand, the children of Israel had light in their homes.
