Chapter 12 - God Institutes The Passover

Exodus 12: 1-6 – Each household should take a lamb.

The coming deliverance from Egypt was such a significant act that God told the children of Israel to remake their calendar. The new year would now start with the month of their redemption from Egypt. It was God's way of saying that everything was about to change.

II Corinthians 5:17

On the 10th of this 1st month each family -or household - was to take a lamb, and the lamb was to live with the family for 4 days until Passover. For the lamb to live with the family for 4 days was for the lamb to become a part of the family. By the time it was sacrificed on the 14th day it was both cherished and mourned. God wanted the sacrifice of something special. The lamb was also to be without blemish. A one-year-old male lamb. This sacrifice unto the Lord had to be as perfect as a lamb could be.

John 1:29

Exodus 12: 7-11 – Instructions for eating the Passover.

Before the Passover lamb could be eaten, its blood had to be applied to the doorway of the home, to the top and upon each side the blood was applied. The blood on the doorposts showed that the sacrifice of the Passover lamb was to be remembered in daily life. You would see it every time you went in or out of the house. The lamb was also to be eaten.

Luke 22: 7-8

Exodus 12: 12-20 The Protection of the Blood.

When I see the blood, I will pass over you. For Israel to be spared the judgment on the 1st born, they had to apply the blood just as God said they should.

Exodus 12: 21-23 Moses leads the people in the observance of the Passover.
