CV First Worship Director (Part Time) Job Description

As the CV First PT Worship Coordinator, you will work closely with the Senior Pastor, CV First staff, and the Worship & AV team to curate and organize worship experiences that create a meaningful and uplifting atmosphere for the congregation. The Worship Director will be responsible for scheduling instrumentalists, vocalists, and audio/visual teams to ensure smooth and seamless execution of worship services. Ther Worship Director will blend creativity, organization, and attention to detail as he/she coordinates various elements of worship sets.

Responsibilities:

- Report directly to the Senior Pastor
- Collaborate with the Senior Pastor, staff, and Worship & AV team to understand the vision and theme for each worship service.
- Curate and create weekly worship sets that include a collection of songs, hymns, readings, announcements, and visuals that align with the service theme and engage the congregation.
- Collaborate with instrumentalists, vocalists, and audio/visual teams to schedule rehearsals and ensure their availability for each service.
- Communicate effectively with team members, providing them with necessary information, music, or other resources in a timely manner.
- Arrange and oversee rehearsals to ensure all performers are proficient in their respective parts and ready for the service.
- Coordinate the setup and testing of audio/visual equipment, ensuring it is in proper working order before each service.
- Ensure that worship sets are prepared and shared with the appropriate team members well in advance to allow for review and practice.
- Stay up to date with the latest worship music trends and recommend new songs or arrangements to keep the worship experience fresh.
- Maintain a roster of available musicians and vocalists, periodically evaluating their skills and providing feedback or training as needed.
- Help maintain and manage the condition of the instruments, equipment, and stage of Worship Center.
- Foster a positive and supportive environment within the worship team, encouraging growth, collaboration, and spiritual connection.
