

FROM OUR SENIOR PASTOR...

This year marks the 105th year of the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering. In 1918, the WMU (Women's Missionary Union) named the annual Christmas offering for international missions after the woman who encouraged them to begin it. Charlotte Diggs Moon was a missionary in China for 39 years (1873-1912), and she was passionate about people knowing Christ.

The world has changed drastically since Lottie's time on the mission field, but people have not. There are approximately 8 billion people in the world and the majority do not know Christ. The Lottie Moon Christmas Offering goes directly to missionaries serving among unreached people groups in unreached places of the world.

Our goal as a church is **\$50,000**. It seems like a huge goal, and it is. But, it is a goal that I believe we can reach if we give together sacrificially. I want to encourage you to give toward this goal. If you gave last year, can you give more? If you have not given, start with anything. We want to celebrate this goal at the end of December, not merely because we reached our goal, but because with this money, we will reach people for Jesus! This is a simple way to get in the Christmas spirit and get excited about the real reason for the season. Let's give the gospel to world.


