FROM OUR SENIOR PASTOR...

This past Sunday and Monday, I was blessed to be at this year's Mississippi Baptist Evangelism Conference hosted at Northcrest Baptist Church. Sunday night, Shane Pruitt, Next Gen(eration) Director for North American Mission Board, preached a powerful message. He gave a spirit-filled, gospel-centered, simple, evangelistic, and revitalizing message from Genesis 1-3. At the response time, there were around 60 professions of faith (at least 30 of them came from students in the William Carey Choir). He made a statement that night that you will find familiar. Quoting him loosely, Pruitt said, "For revival to happen in our nation, revival must happen in our churches. For revival to happen in our churches, it must begin in us individually." Sound familiar?

Monday's message from Pruitt was on how you can tell if a spiritual awakening is happening. Here are his points from Acts 5:27-42. You know spiritual awakening is happening when...

- 1. Obedience is priority.
- 2. The gospel is advancing (Believers are sharing the gospel boldly.)
- 3. There's an awareness of kingdom victory (We can't lose!)
- 4. Mission without fear (The world can't stop us!)

You may ask, "Why are you sharing this with us?" I want you to see that God is up to something amazing and He wants you personally to be a part of it. Our study in Nehemiah is God-ordained and God-timed. While we are studying personal revitalization that leads to corporate revitalization, there are others who are preaching, teaching, and practicing the same truths.

If you're like me, and although you know God is at work, you may ask, "That's great that God moved at the conference like that and that He's doing it in other places, but what's missing in our church?" Response. We need people who will faithfully respond to the gospel. Now, please do not hear me saying that people are not responding in their own ways or that I'm discouraged when people do not respond. That's not it at all. But one person faithfully responding can often lead to others responding. By coming forward to pray; by accompanying a lost friend to the front; by responding in obedience to be baptized or to unite with our faith family can lead to not just a wonderful response time in our worship service, but it can lead to a Holy Spirit movement. I pray that you want to see God move in our response times. I pray that you want God to move in vou during our response times. Will you be obedient to God's drawing? If he moves you, will you step out in faith and respond so that others may follow? I pray we all will do this and that we will continue to see God bring revival to us individually and to our church.
