

FROM OUR CHILDREN'S DIRECTOR...

September always makes me a little extra excited each year. I'm not a fan of sports, so it's not because of football on whatever day of the week it falls on. I'm not a fan of cold weather, so it's not because of the cold fronts that will be making their way into Meridian. September means that our annual Trunk or Treat is right around the corner, and it always excites me so much.

Trunk or Treat is always one of our biggest outreach events that takes place at Highland. So many people from all over our neighborhood and the community come to this event. Trunk or Treat is easily one of my favorite events to do at Highland and I hope that it's one of yours too. If it's not, then you must not have come to any of the Trunk or Treats before. Consider this your sign to attend the Trunk or Treat this year. And consider this an extra sign to volunteer at our Trunk or Treat this year!

Last year at Trunk or Treat, we gave out close to 35,000 pieces of candy and had 23 trunks that walked through stories in the Bible. But that's not all—we also had 76 in-depth gospel conversations, 7 people accepted Christ as their Lord and Savior, and we had 2 baptisms that night. It was a great day last year, but I expect the Lord to do even more at this year's Trunk or Treat! But I cannot do Trunk or Treat without you!

You can help with Trunk or Treat in a few ways:

- 1. **Donate Candy**. We need 35,000 pieces of candy, so in order for the candy population to steadily replenish, that means we need to start collecting candy today. You can grab candy next time you go to the store and then drop that candy off in the white baskets that are placed around Highland, or check out the Highland Facebook Page and shop the Amazon wish list that has been shared.
- 2. **Sign up for a trunk**. This is the most important part of Trunk or Treat (if you couldn't already tell from the name of the event). There are two different types of Trunks that you can sign up for: a "Jesus Trunk" or a "Basic Trunk".
 - a. Jesus Trunk: I will supply you with everything you need. Decorations, candy, and a script. I just need you to bring a car, and someone that can read the script and pass out candy. There are 14 of these trunks that give our guests the opportunity to walk through Jesus' life from His birth to His resurrection.
 - b. Basic Trunk: You come up with a biblically based theme, and you decorate it. I'll supply you with the candy.
- 3. **Sign up as a volunteer**. There are a few places where you will be able to serve at Trunk or Treat. This might be a Cake Walk, serving popcorn or cotton candy, or supervising the inflatables/games.

No matter how you are wanting to serve at Trunk or Treat, there is a place for you, and this is an "all hands on deck" type of event. If you do not have a "job" at Trunk or Treat, I ask that you come and help share the gospel with our guests, since that is the main reason for this event.

I am looking forward to Trunk or Treat and I hope you are too! Please let me know how you wish to serve at Trunk or Treat this year. Trunk or Treat will take place on October 27 from 4:00PM until 6:00PM at Highland's lower parking lot. See you there!
