Back in the summer, Bro. David and I had the opportunity to travel to Canada to meet with several pastors and ministers in the area about the possibility of Highland partnering with them in their missional efforts to see all of British Columbia fall in love with Jesus. The city of Vancouver, and really the province of British Columbia as a whole, is one of the most non-religious areas in all of North America. David and I both left that trip burdened by the Holy Spirit that this was an area we were being called to evangelize.

With this being said, there are a group of high school students and adults who will be traveling to Vancouver next July to partner with a church plant and with a ministry that works exclusively with Iranian refugees who are in desperate need of having physical needs met as well as having an even more desperate need to be introduced to a Savior who loves them. This team will work with the church plant to reach young families through intentional evangelistic outreach. We are still working through the details, but this will be through a type of family festival with games, prizes, and the Gospel being shared. We will also be working with the House of Omeed. Omeed is the Farsi word for Hope. This is appropriately named because this ministry provides hope to people who are coming into a foreign country with none. They provide food, legal help, school for children, and are constantly looking for opportunities to introduce these refugees to Jesus.

This is a costly trip, and we will be fundraising over the next several weeks by selling Boston butts, smoked whole turkeys, and smoked turkey breasts. The Boston butts and turkey breasts are \$40 each while the whole turkey is \$45. You can purchase one (or more) of these by seeing any of our teammates and buying a ticket. Please reach out to me and I will supply you with a list of who all is selling them. These profits will go directly to helping pay for this trip. You can buy them up until November 10th and they'll be available for pickup on Tuesday, November 26th at the church in the upper parking lot from noon - 4:00PM. If you are unable to pick up during that time, we can make other arrangements. Thank you so much for supporting our ministries here at Highland as we attempt to see our city, state, nation, and the world fall in love with Jesus.
