The facility accommodates potentially 400-500 attendees during warmer months and smaller groups year-round. It offers both open-air and climate-controlled facilities to support varying group sizes and seasonal needs. Its design reflects CPP security standards, specifically for lodging, showers, and restrooms.

Valuing our debt-free philosophy, the facility is financed through gifts from Otter Creek members and fees from its usage. The facility will be financially self-sustaining.

The ideal site possesses woods, large open spaces, and access to a body of water, all while being accessible by bus. Ideally it will be within a 2-hour radius of Brentwood, close enough for a one- or two-night stay yet remote enough to allow for wonder. The site is safe for all ages and free of any adverse conditions (e.g., elevated, unsecure bluffs).
