## **Use Holy Week to Prepare for Easter**

Based on Mk at Procession 11:1-10; Is 50:4-7; Phil 2:6-11; Mk 14:1-15:47

Jerusalem buzzes with excitement and overflows with people gathering to celebrate Passover. They also want to see Jesus, the miracle-worker and teacher, coming with his disciples.

As Jesus arrives, the crowds enthusiastically and joyfully cry out, "Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!"

The crowds press around Jesus, waving palm branches and spreading their cloaks on the road to welcome him.

The Jews have been waiting for a Messiah to free them from Roman rule. Although the crowds greet Jesus as a king, he doesn't come as a warrior king riding on a spirited stallion, but as a Messiah of peace riding on a gentle donkey.

Amid the excitement and frenzy, the chief priests are fearful Jesus will have more power over the people than they. They secretly plan to kill Jesus.

In five days, the cheers turn to jeers. The Gospel continues with events leading to Jesus' death on the cross and burial. This Gospel is called the "Passion," from the Latin word "passio" which means "suffering."

Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord is the beginning of Holy Week, the most important and sacred week of the year, recalling Jesus' love for us and all that he encountered on his final journey to Jerusalem – praise and celebration, treachery, betrayal, condemnation, brutal suffering, death on the cross and burial.


Spend Holy Week preparing for the glorious feast of Jesus' Resurrection on Easter by:

- Praying the Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary, and the Stations of the Cross.
- Attending church on the special days of Holy Week Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday.
