

#### REFLECTION

Fr. Dennis was installed as pastor of St. Dominic Catholic Parish in October 2018, after serving for one year as parish administrator. His faith is based on the fact that we are all called to respond to God's love. He loves us first, and in that invitation is answered a desire that is deep within all of us.



Let me introduce you to my uncle Joey. He was the youngest in my father's family of seven. As Joey was just two years younger, he was my dad's favorite. He apparently was the favorite of many, including my mom, who said to me, "Your dad was nice, but everyone said you should have known his brother, Joey." Two of my uncles, as well as my dad, were in WWII. One uncle and my dad were in the army. My uncle Joey joined the Marines. The war in Europe was over, so he was sent to the Pacific theater. He had just married the love of his life, Wanda, before he left...Joey was killed on the island of Luzon in the Philippines. His patrol had been given incorrect directions and they came upon a Japanese machine gun nest. He helped to get a couple of guys to safety before he was killed. Joey was killed in July of 1945. The war in the Pacific ended on September 2, 1945. And so, every Memorial Day, I think of Joey.

My dad died about 14 years ago. At his funeral, I finally met Wanda, Joey's wife of one year. She had remarried, had a few kids, and now must have been in her 70s. I asked her about Joey. She pulled out a photo of Joey, the first time I had seen him. She carried it with her for all those years despite living a whole new life.

I think Memorial Day is the perfectly named holiday, because it is in our

memory that those who have died, live. I don't have deserving words to express the feelings of this weekend. I have never served in war. I have never seen anyone die in war. What I do know is that there is something fundamentally wrong with us that we engage in war. We call it Original Sin. Some tell us it is a consequence of our God given free will. But as I look at our human history the death and destruction, what a price to pay for the freedom to choose. When will we learn?

Today, we celebrate Trinity Sunday, an offering to share in the love between the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. A blessed and divine unity of love. We do it in the backdrop of the lives lost to give us the opportunity to worship this Trinitarian God in freedom. As I once again think of an uncle I have never met, I thank God for the offering of a love I can only imagine.

## MISSIONARY DISCIPLESHIP

#### Our Work—Our Calling

Last week. I shared some excerpts from a book entitled, " If You Want to Walk on Water, You Have to Get Out of the Boat," by John Ortberg about "discerning the call." As I continued to read the book, I couldn't help but connect its contents to what we are doing to promote The Way with Missionary Discipleship Training and the Called and Gifted Workshop. As disciples, we are keenly aware that our ways are not God's ways. Focusing on the ways of the world diminishes us as children of God. Our identity is in the fact that we are His children. We are His disciples. We are His beloved.

For many of us, our identity is tied to our work. While that isn't a bad thing, it can present a conflict. When discerned properly, our work can be our calling. That is the ideal because one's work then matches God's mission: to work with God's plan as opposed to apart from it.

As people's commitment to family, community, and faith shrink, they begin to look to their careers to provide meaning, identity, connectedness, and esteem. A calling, which is something I do for God, is replaced by a career, which threatens to become my god. A career is something I choose for myself; a calling is something I receive. A career is something I do for myself; a calling is something I do for God. A career promises status, money, or power; a calling generally promises difficulty and even some suffering - and the opportunity to be used by God. A career is about

upward mobility; a calling generally leads to downward mobility. (Walk on Water p. 71)

As we ponder our individual roles in The Way, now would be a good time to evaluate our alignment with our calling and our careers. As I do the same thing, I wish to propose these questions for consideration, reflection, and prayer as suggested in "If You Want to Walk on Water, You Have to Get Out of the Boat:"

*To what extent does your current work express your giftedness and passion?* 

What has impulsivity gotten you into trouble? Where have you been likely to mistake foolishness for faith?

Reflect on your life from childhood on:

What activities and causes have brought you most internal joy and fulfillment?

*What limitation that's part of your "raw material" is the most painful to you?* 

*How clear are you about your sense of calling*? Try writing one or two compelling sentences to finish this phrase: My calling is \_\_\_\_\_.

What is one low cost probe you could try to explore your calling further?




