Dear families of St. Dominic Catholic School,

While this was said tongue-in-cheek, Father's message was important to understand in the context of the Visitation: when Mary was visited by the angel Gabriel who informed her about all of the wonderful work God was doing, she shortly thereafter got up and left to visit with her cousin, Elizabeth, who was with child already (the soon to be born St. John the Baptist). In that moment, Mary could have stopped right then and there and worried about a plethora of outcomes to everything she had just heard about. But rather than doing so, she gets up and literally runs to her cousin to help her and leaves her worries, doubts, and own self-concern behind. Mary, the ever-patient matriarch of the Church, showed us all what it means to be Christian in this day and age: to put others first and to be selfless when doing so.

Especially, as we can see the end in sight (but not quite there yet!), I encourage everyone to find those moments over the last week of school to not only be Christ to someone, but to also emulate the example of Mary, and to let go of our doubts and concerns and rush to someone who may be in need of a friend to lean on. What a wonderful end to the school year it would be if we could all find it in ourselves to give that to someone else. Imagine how much "crabbiness" would be alleviated if we all did!

Simplified Extended Care Fees Effective January 1, 2024

We are happy to provide excellent before and after school care for our students. Extended Care is an important part of supporting the overall needs of our families.

It also is important for us to recognize that when raising kids – sometimes plans and schedules change.

Our revised Extended Care Fee Structure reflects the following simplifications:

- Fees are billed Per Child/Per Hour (in 15 minute increments)
- Fees are billed for Time Used ONLY (rounded to the next quarter hour)
- No penalty charged for picking up your child(ren) earlier than what you scheduled
- No time, fines or penalties will be billed for Communicated Schedule Cancellations (*Cancellations must be reported in writing BY NOON of the day of scheduled care*)
- Late Pick Up Fee is a flat amount (No longer cumulative of Fee plus \$/per minute)

Billing statements for the prior-week's care will continue to be generated and e-mailed to families each Monday morning, with auto-payments initiated each Monday afternoon.

If there was a change to your schedule or a question regarding care received \sim please work to resolve those concerns As They Happen. It is easier to change a child's attendance log prior to billing than to research and obtain an adjustment to a billed amount.

We Share in Jesus' Death and Resurrection

Based on: Ex 24:3-8, Heb 9:11-15, Mk 14:12-16, 22-26

Not an ordinary supper – the very "first" Eucharist. This Sunday we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, recognizing the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. It's often called by the Latin name Corpus Christi (body of Christ). The readings highlight God's reaching out to all people offering loving commitments and blessings.

This Sunday's Gospel comes from Mark's account of Jesus' Passion. Jesus, with his disciples, was celebrating Passover that commemorated the freeing of the Israelites from Egyptian slavery. At this Last Supper, Jesus instituted the Eucharist. He changed the bread and wine into his own body and blood and gave it to his disciples.

As we gather for Mass/Eucharist (which means "thanksgiving"), we recall this meal Jesus shared with his disciples on the night before he died; and we share in his saving death and Resurrection. During Mass, at the offertory, we bring bread and wine to the altar. Just as Jesus prayed at the Last Supper, the priest prays the words of consecration and the bread and wine become the body and blood of Jesus.

Jesus, who taught about God's love, forgave sins, cured the sick, died on the cross and rose from the dead, is the same Jesus we receive in holy Communion at Mass. Jesus, the "Bread of Eternal Life," gives himself to us completely and helps us to be good, strong and loving children of God.

Corpus Christi should help us focus on Christ's love for us – he gave his body on the cross at Calvary; he gives us his body in holy Communion and in the communion, we have with each other in the church as his body on earth.

Jesus, your love for us is beyond our imagination. Help us to give our hearts to you.
