### Radiate Love: Do You Radiate Christ to Others?

*Dr. Edward Sri*

Do you realize the people around you are depending on you to pray every day?

I know that my wife and children, for example, need a lot more than my human love for them. They need Christ loving them through me. But that can only happen if I have a consistent, daily prayer life. I do sincerely love my family. But I also know my love is tainted by my own pride, selfishness, weakness, wounds, and sin. My wife and children need more than what I can give them on my own. They need Christ's love supernaturally working through me. And that comes from daily prayer.

How about you? Consider the people at work, in your parish, and in your community, the people you serve: do you give them more than merely your own personal skills, talent, wisdom, leadership abilities, or charming personality?

We should use all of our humanity, of course, to give the best of ourselves to others in all we do. But the best of ourselves, actually, is more than ourselves. It is Christ radiating through us.

How about your family, your spouse, your closest friends—do the people in your life encounter something in you



bigger than you are? Do they encounter Jesus Christ radiating through you?

Mother Teresa emphasized this point with her Missionary of Charity sisters throughout the world...they recite a prayer that contains this beautiful petition to Jesus: "Shine through us, and be so in us, that every soul we come in contact with may feel your presence in our soul. Let them look up and see no longer us but only Jesus."

What a remarkable prayer! "Let them look up and see no longer us but only Jesus."

Wouldn't it be wonderful if every soul we come in contact with each day—our spouse, our children, our friends, our colleagues at work, the people in the parish, the poor on the street—if every person we meet each day looked up and saw "no longer us but only Jesus!"

If we wish to truly radiate Christ in this world, we must be committed to daily prayer.

## MISSIONARY DISCIPLESHIP

### The Grace of God

Today we celebrate the Baptism of Our Lord. Baptism is no trivial matter. Consider what occurs: Original Sin is removed so that we may experience the life and love of God within us from that moment forward. The life and love of God within us is known as grace. Baptism allows grace to flow freely for the rest of your life. We can't get rid of it. God is always in us! Sit with that for a moment. God is in you! God never leaves you! You CAN'T get rid of Him. God is in you and with you all the days of your life. Ponder that, beloved son/daughter.



Baptism is an incredible gift. This sacrament sets us on a course for an incredible adventure with God. A course that we, at any moment, can accept or reject. Not being baptized prevents good things from happening. The grace of God is a really good thing! As we grow in our discipleship, we are able to choose whether or not to follow Jesus. That is also a gift we are given, the gift of free will. Regardless of what we do, God never leaves us. There is nothing in our human experience to compare that to. At some point, every earthly thing can leave us. There is nothing as constant as the love of God. This can make it very hard to accept, but we have no

choice in the matter. What we can choose to accept is our side of the arrangement. We can speak and act contrary to our innate goodness by our own free will. We can do anything to try to make Him not love us, but it won't work. We are His pride and joy!

God loves us so very much. He wants nothing more than for each one of us to be in relationship with Him – bruises, bumps, imperfections, warts, sins and all. He sees us as the perfect beings He created us to be. He sees us before the sins and wants us to return to that, to heal us. His heart hurts that we hurt. In that love though, He is just. This means we do have to work at it. We do have to put the time in to get to know Him, love Him, and serve Him and our fellow human beings. That is why a life with God is an adventure. Choosing God means that you have to mean it. To mean it, you have to work at it. We are all at different stages of what that looks like. Not a one of us does it the way someone else does. We shouldn't. Our discipleship is unique to each person. We fall off the rails when we start comparing. Comparing steals the joy of what a life with Christ is. It is between you and Him.

Take time to tap into your baptism and the promises that were made by you or on your behalf. Evaluate your relationship with the Trinity. Do you mean what you say? Are you saying what you mean? ### Today's Gospel Reading






