## Fill Jesus Up

Do you know the song "It's My Party" by Lesley Gore? While I might be dating myself on that one, I grew up listening to "the oldies." In reading today's Gospel, this is what popped in my head. For not only did I read the Gospel, but also the verses that come after it where Jesus laments for Jerusalem. Jesus is crying at His own party.

Have you ever felt sad at a party? I have. Now that I think about it, I may have felt sad at a party on more than one occasion. What would cause one to be sad at their own party?

- Knowing that the joy and fun of the party will come to an end.
- Maybe a certain special person isn't there that you wanted to be there.
- Realizing that you have spent so much time making sure that everything is "just so" that you miss the moments of connection (I call this a Martha Moment).

There most certainly may be more, but you get the idea. While I have never experienced anything like Jesus did, I can imagine that this event was anything but celebratory for Him, or was it? What would cause Him to be sad at His party?

- He is aware that this moment is fleeting.
- He is aware that terrible suffering is looming.
- He is aware that His disciples aren't quite getting it and that is frustrating.
- He is aware that He is going to die a very painful and humiliating death in a few days.

With all this being known, does He participate in the party? He most certainly does! How can I tell? He rebukes the Pharisees. Jesus is enjoying the celebration and wants it to keep going. It may be just what He needs knowing what He knows. The cheers of recognition and love are filling His cup before His cup is emptied.

Take the opportunity of this Palm Sunday to fill up Jesus's cup before He pours it all out for us this Holy Week. Give Him everything you have by prayer and supplication so that Good Friday is so, so good!

Thank you, Jesus, for preparing such a tremendous banquet for us. We can't wait to join you at the heavenly feast where there will be no more crying. Ever.

## MISSIONARY DISCIPLESHIP

### Blessed is the King

Consider the scene in today's Gospel: the triumphant entry of Jesus into Jerusalem.

Imagine that you are there, in Jerusalem, gathering your items to celebrate the Passover. You take your lamb to the temple between noon and 3:00 as you hear the temple priests chant the Hallel Praises from Isaiah. You head to the market to collect the greens and bitter herbs as well as the apples, raisins, walnuts, and spices for the charoseth. You take time to select the proper wine. Don't forget the flour for the unleavened bread.

As you mindfully work your way through your list, you hear a commotion near the city gate. There is chanting and waving of branches. You start to wonder what might be going on as this is rather unusual despite the hustle and bustle of this important day of preparation. Curiosity gets the better of you, so you go and look.

As you move your way through the crowd, you see a collection of people just outside the gate waving their branches like flags, some are laying down their cloaks and blankets, appearing to be honoring this man entering the city on a donkey. "Who is this man?" you wonder to yourself.

*"Blessed is the king who comes in the name of the Lord."*

What a curious statement the crowds are making. You try to get a better look when you overhear that this man is Jesus of Nazareth. You had heard about Him. He seems

quite amazing from the stories you've heard, and now, there He is in the flesh. Your heart fills with excitement. You are compelled to join in the cheering.

This is Him, the one everyone has been talking about and waiting for. He is here! You can't contain yourself. You shout and wave and jump up and down joining the excitement of the crowd. He's here! He's here!

My friends in Christ, Jesus is here! He is here! He is always here! Take the excitement of this day and carry it forward as we enter into the darkest of times. It will provide the hope to pull you through the holiest of weeks. Jesus has already saved us so we must honor him with our praise and thanksgiving as we recall all that He has done to get us to this point. He is so good! He loves us so much! He is our everything. Lean into Him and learn from Him. This is The Way.

### Seeing with Eyes Wide Open

Listening to the documentary “Living in the Time of Jesus,” the Biblical account of the blind man cured in the Pool of Siloam made me think of how often this literal miracle is also an analogy for the blind spots we have with or without 20/20 vision. According to the Department of Homeland Security, roughly 300,000 underage migrant children have been “lost” since 2021. Human Trafficking (forced labor and sex), especially of boys and girls, is hiding in plain sight. With the arrests of professional traffickers came news last week that many of those children are now presumed dead. Jesus’ disciples wondered if the blind man was blind because of the sins of his parents. I wonder if these kids have suffered and died because of the blindness of society. ### Today's Gospel Reading

Take a moment to sit with today's Gospel: Luke 19:28-40. Allow the Spirit to work in you, with you, and through you.

Today's Gospel reminds us that the same people who waved palm branches at Jesus and proclaimed "Hosanna" are the ones who days later shouted "crucify him!" What would it take for you to be able to proclaim "Hosanna" no matter what is happening in your life?

When in your life have you been betrayed? How did you feel? How can you invite Jesus into that moment?

Peter denying Jesus three times brings out the humanity in each of us. Peter testifies that he was ready to die for Jesus and shortly after, he denies even knowing Him. Let us ask ourselves, am I willing to die for Christ, to be mocked and treated unfairly because I know Jesus? Or am I, like Peter, afraid of what might happen to me if others realize that I know Jesus?

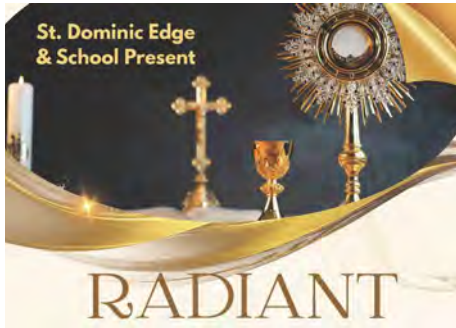

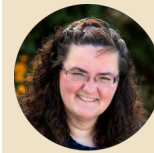

## Seven Churches Pilgrimage

The Seven Churches Pilgrimage is the practice of visiting seven different churches on Holy Thursday, in imitation of the journey of Christ on the eve of his crucifixion. The devotion is thought to have originated in sixteenth-century Rome, where pilgrims, likely led by St. Philip Neri, would visit the seven major basilicas there. At the end of each Holy Thursday Mass, the priest strips the altar and removes the Eucharist from the tabernacle to place it in repose on another nearby altar.

Pilgrims undertaking this journey anywhere in the world can visit any seven churches while adoring Christ in the Blessed Sacrament upon the Altar of Repose, fulfilling his request of his disciples to stay with him as he awaited his Passion. There are specific Scripture passages that pilgrims can meditate upon at each altar. Prayer guides can be found online.

## **Faith, Memory & Culture – The Holy Places**

Holy Land Franciscans and staff maintain the holy places and shrines. This enables those who live in the Holy Land and those who visit to deepen their faith and their spiritual and cultural connection to salvation history.

## **Social & Charitable Activities**

In order to assist Christians to remain in the Holy Land, including the poor and young couples, the Custody builds thousands of residential units. Additionally, they build senior care facilities. Medical assistance is provided for the needy.

## **Educational & Scientific Activities**

The Franciscans operate and support schools open to all, regardless of religion or nationality. They provide scholarships for young men to answer the call to become Franciscan priests

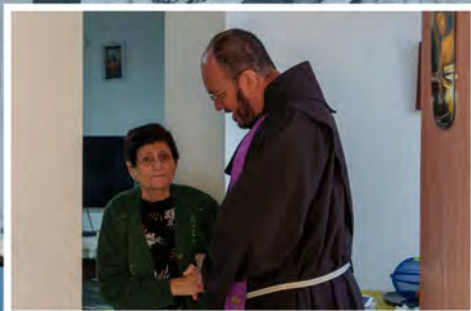
and brothers. Additionally, Franciscan archaeologists pursue ongoing research at the Holy Places.

## **Pastoral Activities**

The Franciscans provide pastoral care in 29 parishes in the Holy Land offering worship, Christian formation, and necessary youth and family programs, especially in regions affected by war.
