

In The Name of Jesus

Jesus said to his disciples: "Amen, amen, I say to you, whatever you ask the Father in my name he will give you. Until now you have not asked anything in my name; ask and you will receive, so that your joy may be complete."

-John 16:23

On the surface, this passage looks like Jesus is saying that He will give us whatever we want. But is that really what Jesus is saying? I think all of us struggle with prayer, or we aren't admitting we struggle with prayer. I struggle with it too. I know that he promises that he hears me, but sometimes I believe he won't actually provide what I need. It's a belief rooted in a lie that God isn't a good Father, and that I will be left abandoned. But when Jesus says to pray "in my name," he means that we pray in his authority because Jesus has full access to the Father – and through his cross and resurrection he has provided access for us to the

Father. In other words, through Jesus, we have the ear of God because He is God. He and the Father are one. When we pray in Jesus name, we actually pray according to the will of God. The name of Jesus has power. When I ask in the name of Jesus, I can be assured that God will take care of me, according to His will because he works all things for good.

Jesus' words conclude with "so that your joy may be complete." Have you ever experienced complete joy? Have you ever experienced the joy that comes from knowing the One who knows you by name, who rescued you from the power of sin, finding your joy in Him? Communion with God – intimacy with Jesus Himself – is the deepest desire of the human heart. So often I myself fall into believing that other things will fill the void that only He can.

I pray that you also come to know the power of praying "in the name of Jesus," surrendering all to Him who knows the deepest desires of your heart better than you do. "So that your joy may be complete."

CATHOLIC TEACHING

Venerable Fulton Sheen once stated, "There are not over a hundred people in the United States who hate the Catholic Church. There are millions, however, who hate what they wrongly believe to be the Catholic Church – which is, of course, quite a different thing." First, many people do not really know what the Church teaches despite the formation they received. Many people learn through unreliable sources who, more often than not, present a biased or inaccurate perspective. Second, many people do not realize that you can disagree and still remain a member of the Catholic Church. This is due to the Hierarchy of Truth embedded in our Tradition. What we fail to realize is that, in the long run, it is about the relationship you have with Jesus, not whether you follow each teaching to the letter, let alone agree. Jesus came to abolish that. The teachings are there to serve as a guidepost apart from those that have been deemed infallible. Part of being a loyal Catholic is engaging with Church teaching, forming your conscience, and living a life worthy of the call. This is why, as disciples, we need to ask questions and seek Truth through the intellectual tradition of the Church. We should be lifelong learners.

Many people view the Catholic Church as a religion of do's and don'ts. Renown Catholic apologist G.K. Chesterton, a convert to the Catholic Church, said that "these (rules) are not arbitrary, and they're not meant to keep us down. They exist to guide you along the path of joy. Like any good roadmap, they keep you from taking wrong turns,

down paths that will ultimately lead to emptiness and misery. So the Church's rules don't constrain you; they ensure you flourish." Consider it like this, according to an analogy used by Chesterton:

He described a group of children playing on an island with steep sides. He noted that if the children were left on their own, they would likely move toward the center and only play in a small circle, afraid of falling over the edge. But suppose you erected a high fence around the entire island. The children would then be free to run around, play on each inch of its surface. Here's the point: the fence would not constrict their happiness; it would enlarge it. That's how rules of the Church are. They aren't meant to constrict your spiritual life – they're meant to give it life and vigor and keep it moving in the right direction..

Rules bind us together as disciples. It fosters a common understanding and mode of living. In a world where these rules are eroding and confusion reigns, where we are experiencing rapid and disorienting changes, our natural inclination is to gravitate toward order that rules provide. We gravitate toward communities where things makes sense. This is what the Catholic Church provides universally; a place of belonging and order because you know what to expect even if you don't agree.

Today's Gospel Reading


