The role of Director of Finance puts my focus daily on two essential components that make St. Dominic thrive: Charity and Gratitude.

St. Dominic would struggle to meet the goals of our Mission (not to mention keep the A/C on during Mass) if it weren't for the incredible charitable giving by YOU – our parish family. The vitality of our grade school and formation programs remain on a steady growth trajectory because of your financial support.

We, who are entrusted to draft budgets, make investments, process donations, and pay bills, have easy work days when the generosity of parishioners makes it possible to do even more than what we hoped.

My days are filled with true joy and sometimes are overwhelmed with gratitude for the strength of this parish. Your deep commitment to stewardship, which in turn touches the hearts and souls of the community, is an embodiment of "Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also" MT 6:21.

When young adults and teenagers have a direct/hands-on experience with donating or volunteering—it changes their hearts. It takes their adolescent focus off of themselves and provides a sense of purpose and

happiness in putting someone else's needs first. Or the kid who is, for the first time, truly involved in the secret of a surprise party and can't contain loud outbursts because they are feeling more excited to be the giver than the receiver. The giver is charitable; the receiver is grateful.

Some cultural changes have happened in America which put six degrees of separation between the giver and the receiver of kind acts. When we abdicate the role of caring for the needy to other people or government programs, the human-touch can be entirely lost.

The second letter to the Corinthians speaks of giving what we have decided in our hearts, not reluctantly or under compulsion. Yet how often do people give only out of obligation or even worse—become removed from charitable acts completely because taxes are assessed and entitlements are distributed, stripping both charity from the giver and gratitude from the receiver.

In my nearly three years here at St. Dominic, I know that your gifts are not given reluctantly or under compulsion. St. Dominic and Christ's Church is where your Heart is.

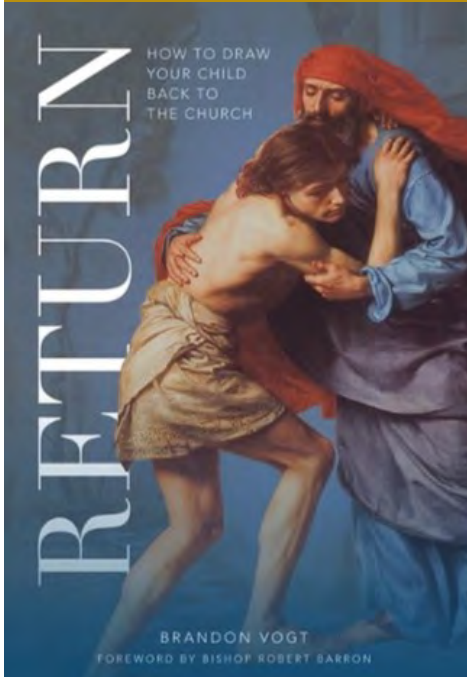
Bus Trip

REFLECTION

Bear Witness

As disciples of The Way, we are to profess in word and deed the joy of the Gospel. This is evangelization. As intimidating of a word as “evangelize” is, we only make it that way out of our own fear. To speak of how God is working in your life is not anything to be afraid of. In fact, to do so is giving praise and thanks where praise and thanks are due. We should be ready to share how God is working in our lives at any moment. To bear witness is one of our parish values. Bearing witness brings others to know Jesus through us. The following is a reflection from Word Among Us for May 26, 2025, that speaks specifically to this topic:

Luke’s Acts of the Apostles is filled with stories about the Holy Spirit’s work among the first believers. What we may overlook, however, are all the ways in which the Spirit was also active in the hearts of those who heard the apostles preach and who responded to the Spirit’s movements. One such story is the conversion of Lydia in Acts 16:11-15.

Along with being a successful businesswoman, Lydia was also a ‘worshiper of God.’ That term means that although she was a Gentile, Lydia believed in the one true God of Israel and sought to live out the Ten Commandments and other parts of the Jewish law. She had also committed herself to pondering and praying through the Hebrew Scriptures. But it took the Holy Spirit speaking through Paul to help her not only to hear his words, but to accept the truth of the good news he

proclaimed.

You probably know people like Lydia – maybe even someone dear to you – who have yet to embrace the ‘life’ in the life-giving message of the gospel. It could be a family member or friend who was raised Catholic but who doesn’t attend Mass regularly because they don’t feel a connection to God or the Church. This can cause you to feel deep pain or even guilt. You may wonder what you can do to help this person. You may even wonder if you’ve somehow failed as a witness to the Lord.

Some of this guilt may come from the mistaken idea that it’s all up to you. That’s just not true! As much as you love someone, as much as you want that person to encounter the Lord, know that Jesus’s love, and his desire for them to encounter him, far exceeds yours! And so, too, does his power to work in their hearts far exceed the persuasive power of your words or example. He may already be working in hidden ways that you can’t even imagine.

So yes, play your part. Let your words and actions reflect the love of Christ. But remember Lydia, and leave room for the Spirit to play his part. Let him ‘open the heart’ of that person in whatever way he wants. Lord, help me to surrender my loved ones to you!

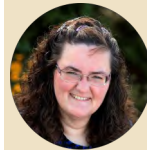

OUR CATHOLIC FAITH



Spiritual Direction, Explained!

Spiritual direction is the practice of seeking counsel from someone who is trustworthy and learned in the faith for the purpose of discerning the will of God in one's life and for more effectively living out one's baptismal call.

All Christians are commanded, in a way, to provide spiritual aid to one another (“Go, make disciples of all nations...teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you” — Matthew 28:19), but a spiritual director is usually an individual who has received some form of training or formation for this specific purpose. The Catholic Church, however, does not have explicit requirements, professional standards, or a formal certification process for spiritual directors. Spiritual directors can be lay, religious, or ordained persons.

Spiritual direction is not to be confused with the sacrament of Penance, though the latter does usually include some spiritual counsel.
