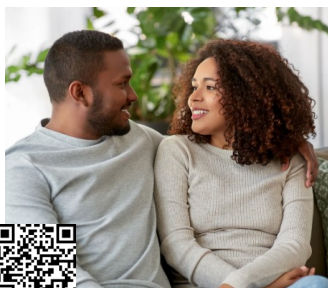

REFLECTION

Sleep & Distractions

Have you ever fallen asleep in prayer?

Have you ever been so distracted in prayer that you felt like you weren't even praying?

These are very common experiences people bring to me for help. Please know that you are not alone. Consider this: if these things happen to you in prayer, God is doing something to you. What God does in prayer is significantly greater than what we do in prayer, provided we give Him the chance.

Did you ever notice that some of the greatest stories in Scripture happen when someone is asleep? God reveals Himself in prayer that looks a lot like sleep. You are no different than those people. God loves sleep – He created a whole day for it! Sleep is important. Now granted, falling asleep in church or in your prayer time is not ideal, but are you really sleeping? A few weeks ago, I mentioned a prayer type known as contemplative prayer. In contemplative prayer, you may begin with a thought or a question and the Lord leads you into a deep space of rest in order to show you a response. You may also be in prayer and distractions pop in, pay attention to what the distractions are showing you. Sometimes the very thing you are distracted by is the thing you need to talk to God about. If your To-Do list pops up, write the thought down so that you can go back to it later, then return to prayer. If a person pops up, take a moment to pray for them or ask God, "Why are you showing me this person, Lord?" He just might be telling you something. Allow your mind to go

there in order to hear His will. If a word pops up, again, ask the Lord what He means in showing you that word. That word can sometimes be the answer to something burdening you. God may be showing you the direction you need to take. This can't happen in a busy, rattled off moment of obligation. This has to happen in a deep, intentional moment of prayer. A moment of encounter where we open ourselves to hearing Him. A moment of awakened faith.

All of these things can seem like distractions but they might not be. Keep in mind that a distraction is something that keeps me from my goal. It is something to persevere through. An excuse gives me permission to return to what I find immediately gratifying. As mentioned earlier, when we sit down to pray, all the things we had forgotten can suddenly seem to be remembered. Sometimes we can use this as an excuse to get up and do those things instead of sitting through prayer. An excuse needs to be rejected. When our intention to wait upon the Lord is firm, we realize that if these distracting reminders are from the Lord, they will come back to us after the appointed time of prayer. The determined effort to "be still, and know that I am God" (Ps 46:11) is the hard work of prayer (And You Will Find Rest, Sattler, Sophia Institute Press, 2024, p.136).

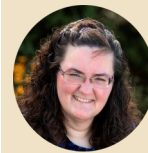

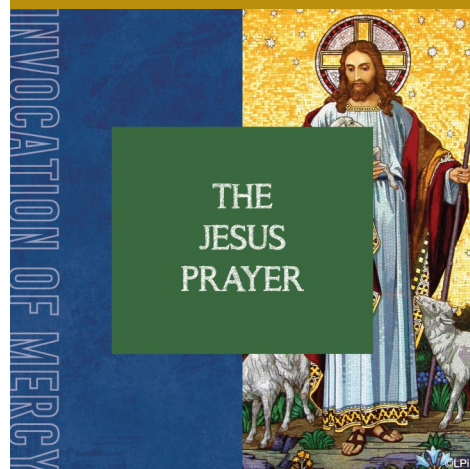

The Jesus Prayer, Explained!

The Jesus Prayer is a short invocation of mercy in the name of Jesus: "Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God, have mercy on me, a sinner."

The exact origins of the prayer are unclear, though it is often attributed to the tradition of Eastern Christianity, possibly via the Desert Fathers (early Christian ascetics who dwelled in Egypt). The prayer has been important to the traditions of both the Eastern Orthodox and the Eastern Catholic faithful. The text echoes the words of the publican in the parable from Luke 18:9-14, whose humble manner of prayer was praised by Jesus. Its short form and simple wording make it ideal for meditative prayer.

The Catechism of the Catholic Church, in paragraph 2667, highlights the Jesus Prayer, saying that "by it the heart is opened to human wretchedness and the Savior's mercy."
