To Be Christ

Be Christ to someone each day.

Seems fairly straight forward. But here's the thing. You may never know how you impacted them.

We say we are a welcoming parish. Following is that charism in action.

This past summer we conducted many interviews. Candidates led us in prayer and we asked questions about how faith will impact their approach. One candidate, who eventually decided to not join us, told us a story of being brought back to Christ and the Church.

Raised in a Catholic family, she fell away during her high school and college years. She "had faith" but wasn't active. When her grandmother passed away, she attended the funeral here at St. Dominic. She was met by very welcoming people (well done funeral ministry team) and witnessed faith in action as people trusted in God's plan for her grandmother. She commented on the Mass, the homily, and the general joy and hope people seemed to have by being Catholic. She missed that feeling. Baby steps led to attending Mass a couple of times here and then at a parish closer to her home. She is now attending regularly and becoming more engaged. She said the nudge she needed was us...you.

Story #2 Before a Sunday Mass recently, a couple said to the hospitality minister, "I don't know your name but you are always here." Introductions were made and another Hospitality Minister introduced himself. Others witnessed and commented. Smiles abounded. Little things to make people welcome.

The challenge is to lather, rinse, and repeat these types of actions...to Be Christ. A few ideas:

Say hi, smile, engage...with someone you do NOT know.

If you see someone down, distant, or with a look of worry on their face...be bold...ask if everything is OK or if they need anything. Listen. You don't need to solve the issue. Just be there for them

Be really bold...offer to pray WITH them

Super bold...do this when you are not at Church. People are seeking and in need of God when they are at the store, the park, at work, etc.

Don't worry, The Holy Spirit will guide you. When you are driving home you will think, "that wasn't too tough." More importantly, you may have changed a life, brought someone to God, and without planning, lived part of our mission **to be Christ**.

OUR CATHOLIC FAITH



The Our Father, Explained!

The Our Father, also known as The Lord's Prayer, is found in the Gospels of Matthew and Luke. Universally beloved in most traditions of Christianity, its words are those of Jesus Christ himself as he answers his disciples' queries on how best to pray.

The version presented in the Gospel of Matthew is longer and more detailed than that which is contained in the Gospel of Luke. Both versions instruct the faithful to address God as "Father," to pray for the coming of His kingdom, to rely on His providence, and to embrace a spirit of forgiveness towards others, in the hope that we ourselves will be forgiven (Matthew 6:9-13, Luke 11:2-4). This last element, forgiveness, is also emphasized by Jesus in the Gospel of Mark (Mark 11:25) as an essential part of all prayer.

The Catechism quotes Tertullian when it calls the Our Father "the summary of the whole Gospel." (CCC 2761).
