As a participant in St. Dominic Parish Summer Trips, I understand that the purpose of a summer trip is to help me focus on my relationship with God, others, and myself. I understand that I will be challenged to try new things, be present to others at camp, and to work on deepening my relationship with God. I understand the more I put into this experience, the more I will get out of it; therefore, I agree to the following:

1. I understand that I will be representing St. Dominic Parish and the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. Responsible behavior as outlined in the Code of Conduct and good judgement is expected of me, and I accept that expectation. Failure to follow this agreement, as it coordinates with the Code of Conduct, will result in me being sent home from camp at my/my family's expense.
2. I will attend the meetings and preparation events as scheduled in order to get to know my fellow campers so I can enter into the camp experience well.
 - a. **Middle School:** I will participate in working the Fish Fry both on March 6 and March 20 to get to know my fellow campers better. A Sign Up Genius will be shared closer to the dates. I agree to attend the **parent** pre-camp preparation night on June 30 at 6:30pm in MC 7. I agree to attend the **camper** pre-camp social on July 14 at 6:30pm in MC 7. If signing up for Mission of Mercy, I agree to attend the **Parent/Student** Pot Luck on Sunday, July 5 at 5:30pm.
 - b. **High School:** I will participate in working the Fish Fry both on March 6 and March 20 to get to know my fellow campers better. A Sign Up Genius will be shared closer to the dates. I agree to attend the **camper** pre-camp social on June 14 in MC 7 following the 11:00am Mass.

CODE OF CONDUCT

We are very excited that you are joining us for our Summer Camp trip to Camp Cana! (Students participating in Mission of Mercy will receive a separate Code of Conduct electronically.)

Each year it is our goal to grow closer as disciples of Jesus Christ and as a St. Dominic Parish community while at camp. Part of being in community, and a disciple of Christ, is responsibility for yourself and for others. With this in mind, we ask that parents and youth participants read the Code of Conduct. **Both a parent and youth participant must sign the Code of Conduct to indicate that both have read and agree to these expectations.**

- As a representative of St. Dominic Parish, I will act with respect, consideration, and kindness toward all Adult Chaperones, fellow campers, camp staff, summer missionaries, bus drivers and anyone else I may interact with while at camp.
- I understand that traveling out of town on a youth trip and attending Summer Camp is a privilege and not a right. My conduct and behavior at any time could affect my ability to attend Summer Camp in the future.
- I understand that Adult Chaperones are spending a week away from their families, taking vacation time from their jobs, and are not paid to go to camp. These amazing adults are volunteers who love Jesus, love camp, and love youth ministry! We literally cannot attend camp without them. I will always listen to and follow their instructions and will thank them and offer to help them whenever possible.
- If I feel uncomfortable in or with a situation or another adult/camper I will confide in a St. Dominic Adult Chaperone.
- I will be present and on time for all camp activities including, but not limited to, Mass, meals, sessions, small groups, and parish snack chat.
- I will engage in all camp activities in a safe manner with a positive attitude.
- During free time, I will let a St. Dominic Adult Chaperone know where I am going to be spending my free time.
- I will follow all camp rules including but not limited to:
 - I will not wander off from the group or to areas I'm told are off limits.
 - I will not sneak out of the cabins at night.
 - I will adhere at night to "lights out" and strive to get a good night's sleep.
 - I will dress modestly in accordance with Summer Camp guidelines (no short-shorts, tank tops, sandals, etc.)
 - I will remain fully clothed in any public areas and when in front of open doors or windows of camp quarters.
 - I will respect everyone's physical boundaries and property.
 - I will not play pranks on other campers or enter another camper's room without being invited.

CODE OF CONDUCT – CONTINUED

- **Camp policy does not permit phones (tablets, portable gaming devices, smart watches, etc.) to be used at camp.** I will only use my phone on the bus to listen to music to and from camp. I will have only appropriate music (no profanity or degrading lyrics) on my device. I will not text or engage in any social media platforms while on the bus. I will not take or post pictures of others. Failure to comply will result in phones being taken and not returned until arriving home. Leaders will collect phones when arriving at camp and return them at departure or in case of an emergency.
- **Possession or use of any illegal drugs, tobacco products, alcohol, Juuls, vaping devices, needles, drug paraphernalia, fireworks/explosives, guns, knives/pocket knives/multi-tools, pepper spray, matches/lighters, or pornographic material is strictly prohibited while partaking in any student ministry event.** I understand that if I am in possession of any of these or other related items, parents will be contacted immediately. I understand that in some cases the local authorities may be contacted as well. I understand that violating this guideline puts my future participation in other student ministry programs in jeopardy.
- **Bullying behavior will not be tolerated at camp.** Bullying is more than misconduct. Bullying behavior is intentional and repeated against the same student or group over time. An isolated incident is not bullying and will be addressed under the parish's policy. Bullying includes but is not limited to the following: verbal harassment of another, indirect harassment through exclusion or intimidation, being an active bystander which reinforces the mean behavior of another, or physical violence or threat of physical violence. Should bullying behavior be identified, the disciplinary guidelines of the camp will be followed with special attention being given to parent communication in cooperation with the camp counselor. The parish staff representative at camp will be in communication with the Pastor and Director of Discipleship and Formation for appropriate guidance and direction.
- I will treat the bus and all camp property with care and respect. Any damages I cause to the bus or camp property are my/my family's financial responsibility.
- I understand that failure to comply with any of these expectations may result in my immediate dismissal from camp with transportation home at my/my family's expense.
