





- **Mission & Discipleship:** The spirit of discipleship thrives in our classrooms, highlighted by service initiatives such as the "Socks for Soles" drive.
- **Catholic Schools Week & Open House:** Planning is underway for our Sunday Open House. The subcommittee is developing an interactive family scavenger hunt and a guided tour script. Student Council members will assist with tours, while the PAAC will host a pancake breakfast with informational tables stationed throughout the building.
- **Operational Efficiency:** We are currently auditing our administrative workflows to streamline the registration and inquiry processes. This includes the development of an updated digital inquiry form.
- **Enrollment Status:** Registration for the upcoming term is currently in progress; final enrollment figures will be confirmed as the cycle matures.
  - i. **Assessments:** Current MAP data indicate a degree of variability in performance results. Relatedly, the Archdiocese is working toward a unified assessment framework and profiling system to ensure consistency across all elementary schools.
  - ii. **Personnel Update:** Following the resignation of our 7/8th-grade teacher, Mrs. Daggett has agreed to fill in to ensure instructional continuity. We are currently in the active recruitment phase and are interviewing qualified candidates for the permanent role.



- iii. **Curriculum & Standards:** Our primary focus remains on measuring the tangible impact of standards application and refining grade-level scopes and sequences to ensure robust demonstrations of student learning.
- iv. **Operations & Equity:** We are continuing our collaborative efforts with the Finance department, Michael Ricci, and Father Dennis to improve staffing transparency and ensure salary equity across the organization.


